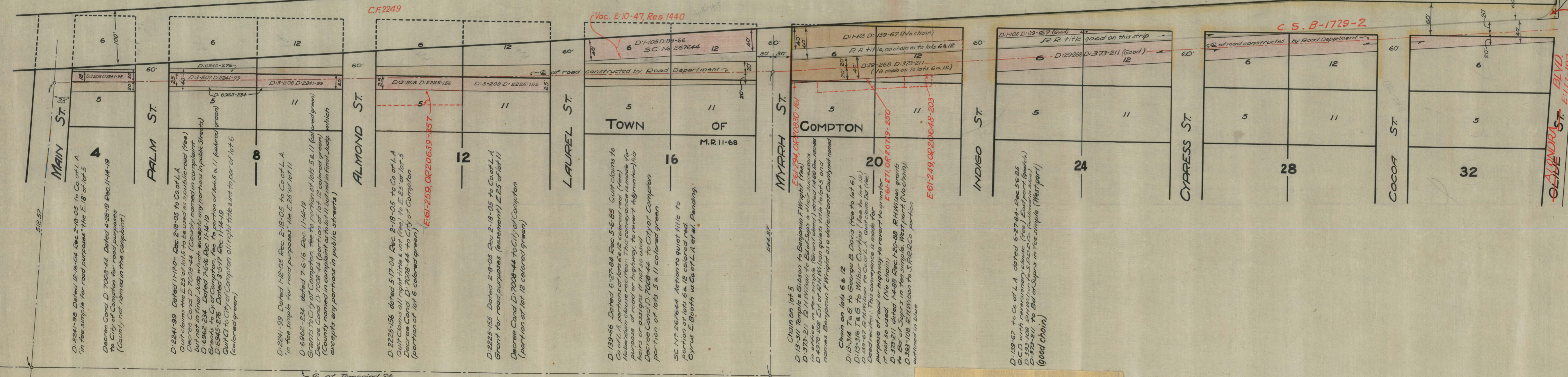
ORDINANCE No 118, of the City of Compton, Dated April 2, 1918 (D: 73-53)
An ordinance authorizing and permitting the use of Alameda Street from the Northerly to the Southerly boundary lines of the City of Compton, within the said City of Compton, by the Board of Supervisors and Road Commissioners of Los Angeles County, for constructing and maintaining thereon a highway, to be used as a part of the County system of roads etc.
