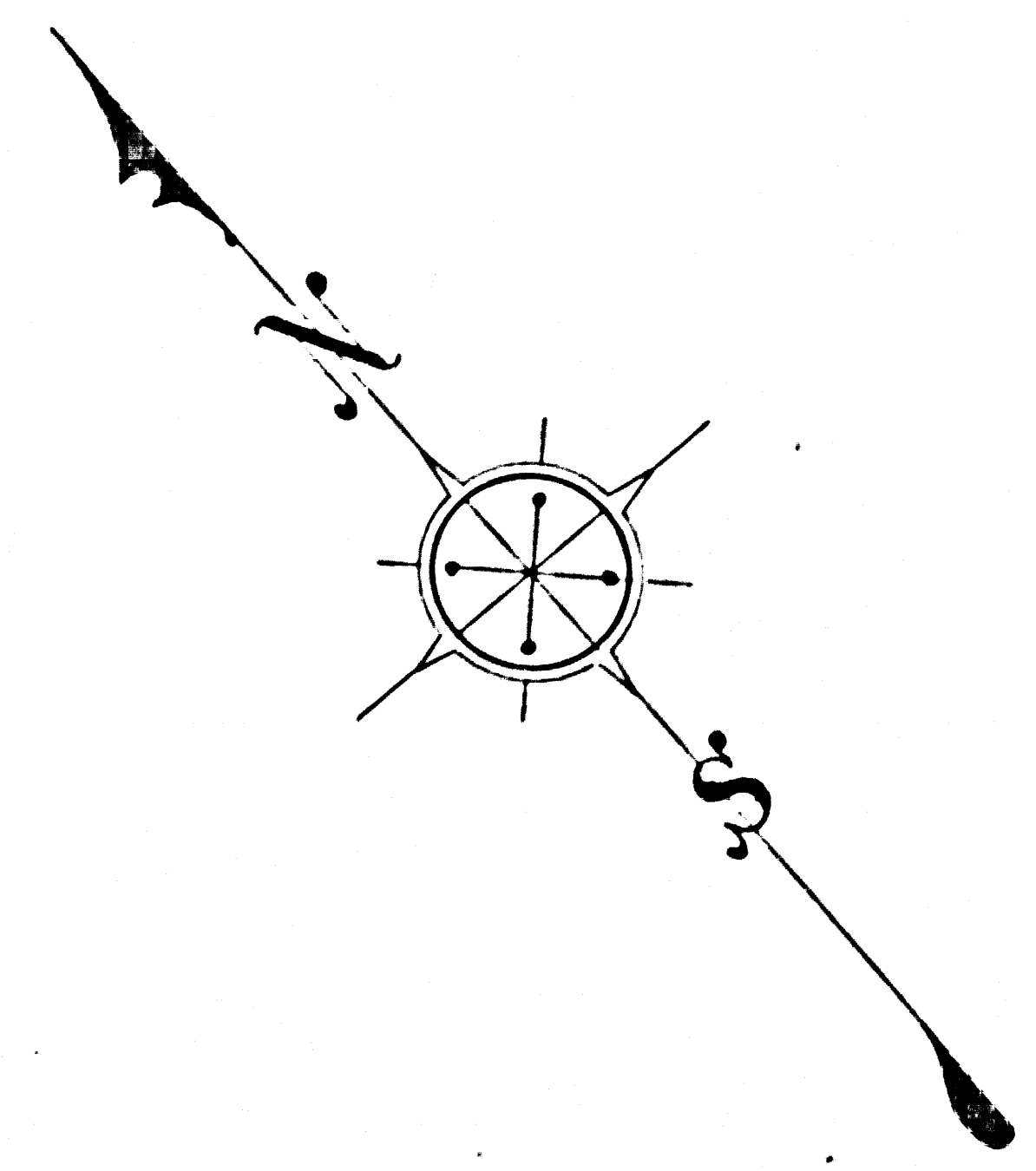


The elevation of the mean high tide of the Pacific Ocean is 193 feet above mean sea level per U.S.G.S. Bench Marks.

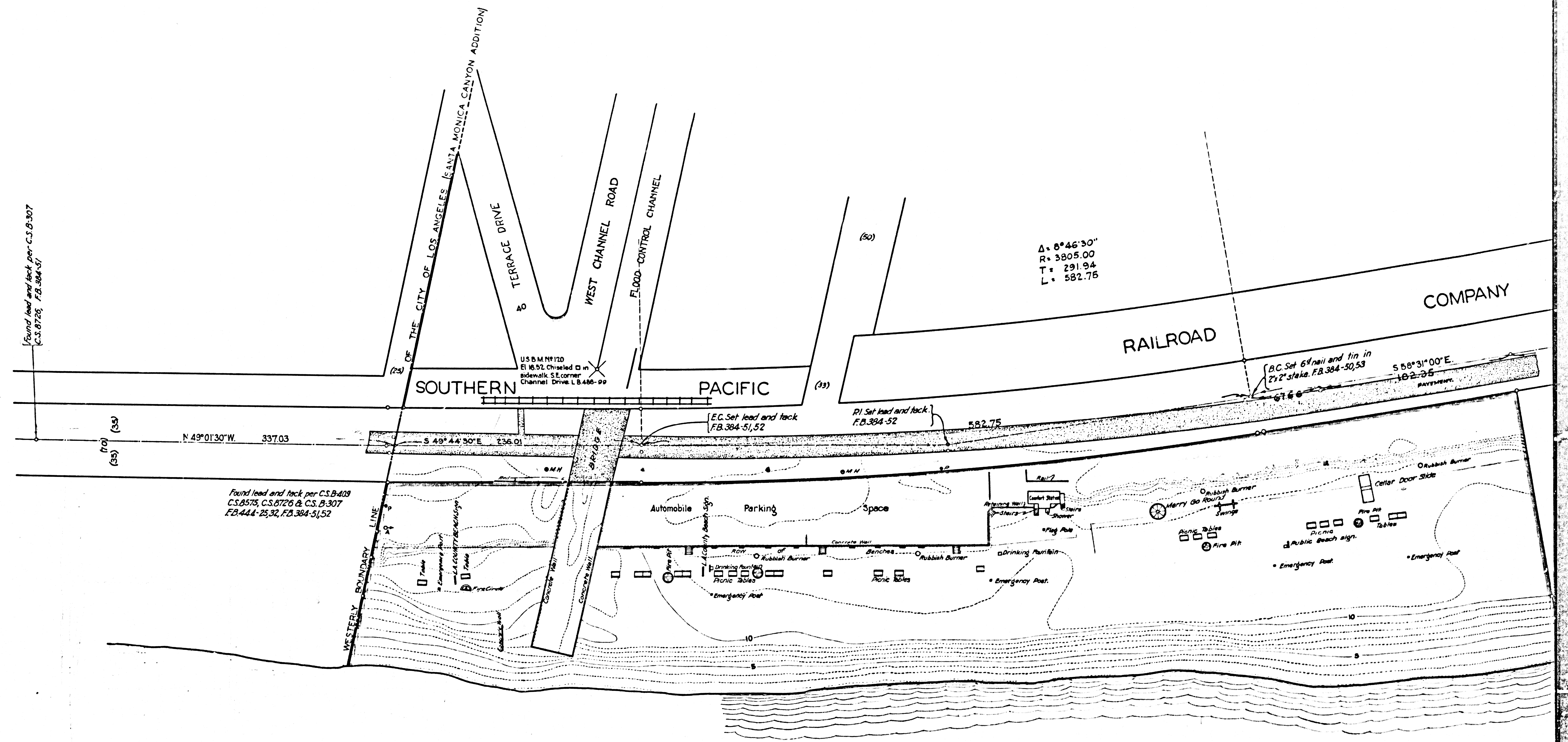
