Original U.S. Land Office Survey in the north half of T.8N.-R.16W. was made by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Ralph W. Norris in 1855. For his notes see C.S. 9102. W. J. Rowan in connection with his survey of the Rancho La Brea in 1871 established the north and east Township boundaries and also the Rancho boundary. See C.S. 8195. C.A. Ensign in 1891 established the survey of certain properties in the north half of the Township in 1891. First reestablished the south lines of Sections 13, 14, 15, and 16, then he set the interior Section Corners that he needed north of that line by single proportion in a north and south direction. See L.S. 8196. Although Ensign's Corners were not set directly according to the U.S. Land Office prescribed methods, no where do his lines vary much from the cardinal directions or from Norris' report lengths. No sections are shorted, and they fit up well with the late U.S. Land Office Survey in the South half of the Township made by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Pearson in 1901. Ensign and Rowan's monuments have been in place and on record for 17 or more years without a serious objection from the affected property owners, therefore the County Surveyor has accepted their monuments where found.
