Beginning at a point called "Los Bariles" 30.39 chs. North and 37.38 chs East of South-west corner of Sec. 6 of Township 5 South range 13 West of San Bernardino Meridian and Base running thence along high water mark S. 61° W. 730 chs, thence S 22 1/2° W 11.50 N. 14° E 2.40, N. 62 1/2° E 1.41, S. 20° E 3.00 S. 63° E 1.50, S. 23 1/2° E 1.50, S. 16° W 4.00 N. 78° E 2.65 S. 43° E 1.20, S. 19° E 1.50, S. 14 1/2° E 3.00, S. 52 1/2° E 1.57 S. 4° E 2.00 S. 12° W 4.50 N. 66° E 3.15 S. 11° E 4.85, S. 9° W 8.70 S. 19° W 3.75 S. 28 1/2° W 4.50 S. 46° W 8.16 S. 53° W 6.50 N. 78° W 0.70 N. 10° W 3.60, West 2.50 S. 5 1/2° W 1.81, S. 76 1/2° W 3.00, S. 24° E 2.87 S. 44 1/2° W 6.27, N. 70° W 3.70, N. 62 1/4° W 7.50, S. 72° W 3.27, South 2.50 to quarter sect. mound of Sec. 11.
