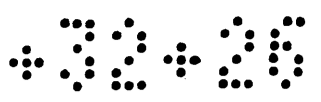


The town laid out in the centre of this tract contains 36 Blocks Each block is a square of which the sides are $8\frac{1}{2}$ chains or 550 feet long containing $6\frac{3}{100}$ acres. The interior streets of this town are all 1.00 chain wide. The streets on the boundary line of this town are 0.50 chains wide. All streets run North and South East & West. The hills north of lots contain 428.655 acres.
