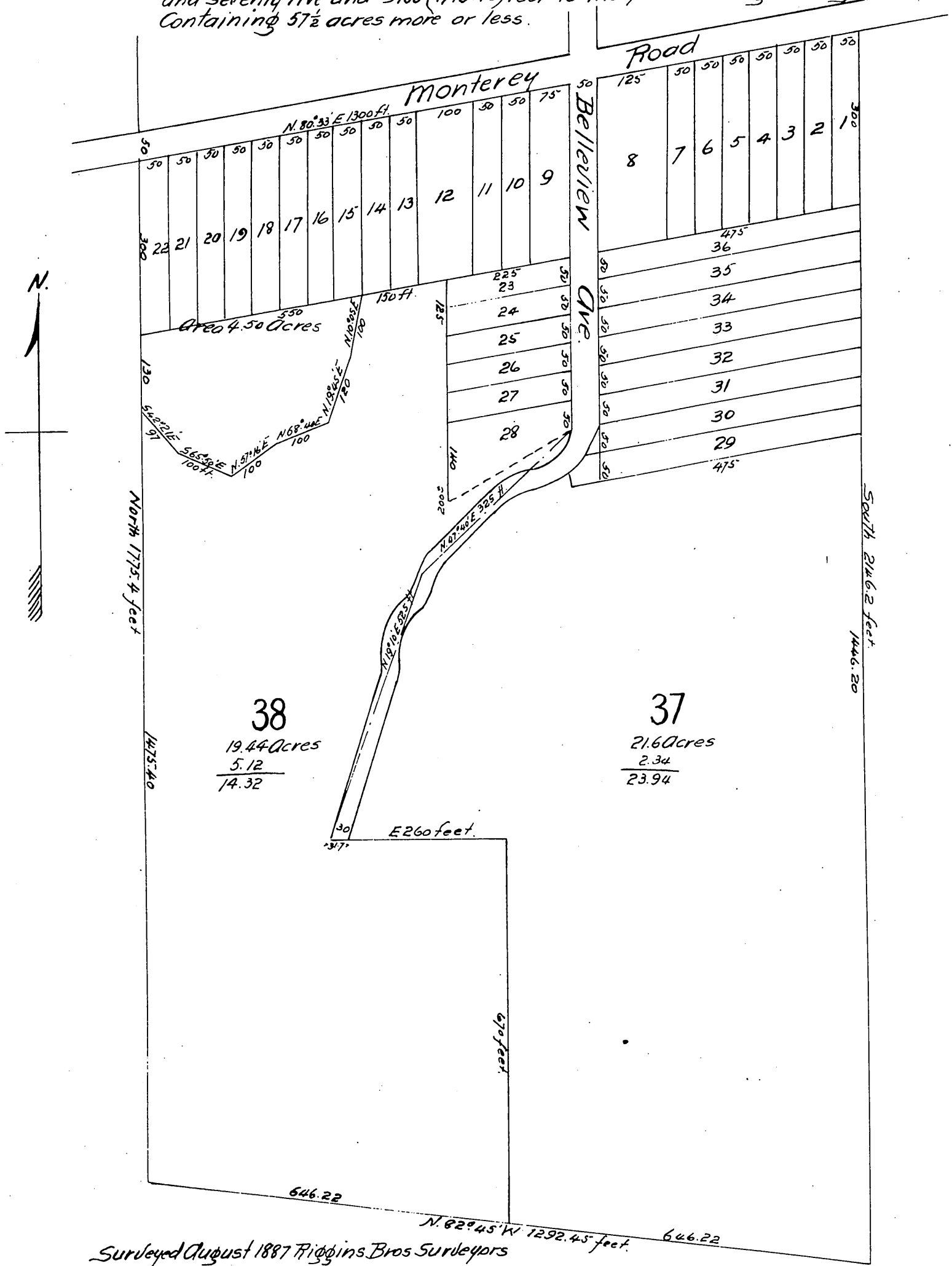


Thomas Green's Subdivision

South Pasadena Highlands

Being a subdivision of the following described land:
 Commencing at a point in the South line of the Monterey road distant fifty feet south from the southwesterly corner of Division I of the subdivided lands of the San Gabriel Orange Grove Association as shown on map of said lands recorded in Book 2, Pages 556 et seq. Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County and running from said point of commencement N. 80° 33' E thirteen hundred (1300) feet; thence south twenty one hundred and forty six and $\frac{20}{100}$ (2146.20) feet; thence N. 82° 45' W. twelve hundred and ninety two and $\frac{45}{100}$ (1292.45) feet; thence North seventeen hundred and seventy five and $\frac{40}{100}$ (1775.40) feet to the place of beginning
 Containing 57½ acres more or less.
