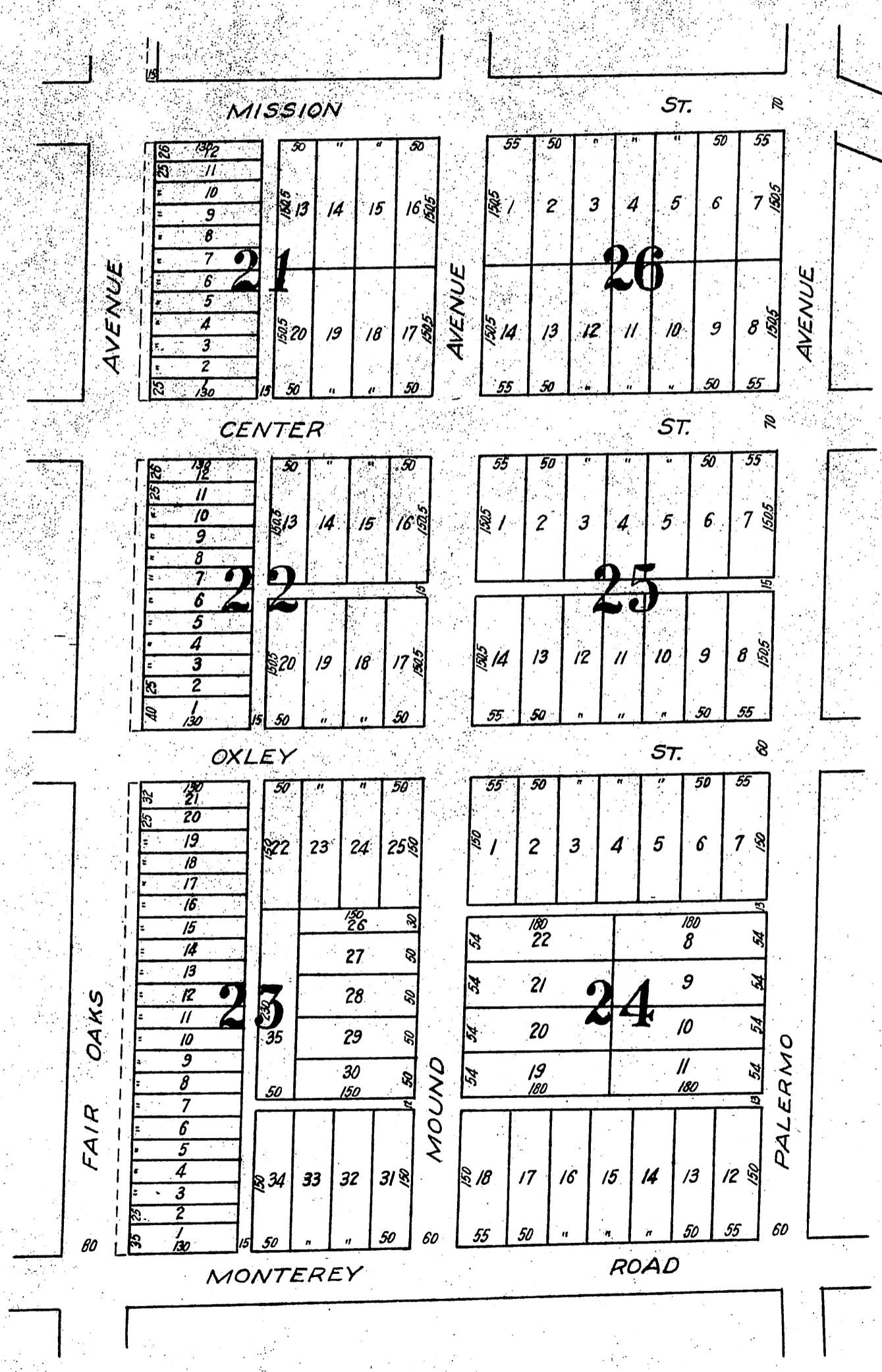


MAP
