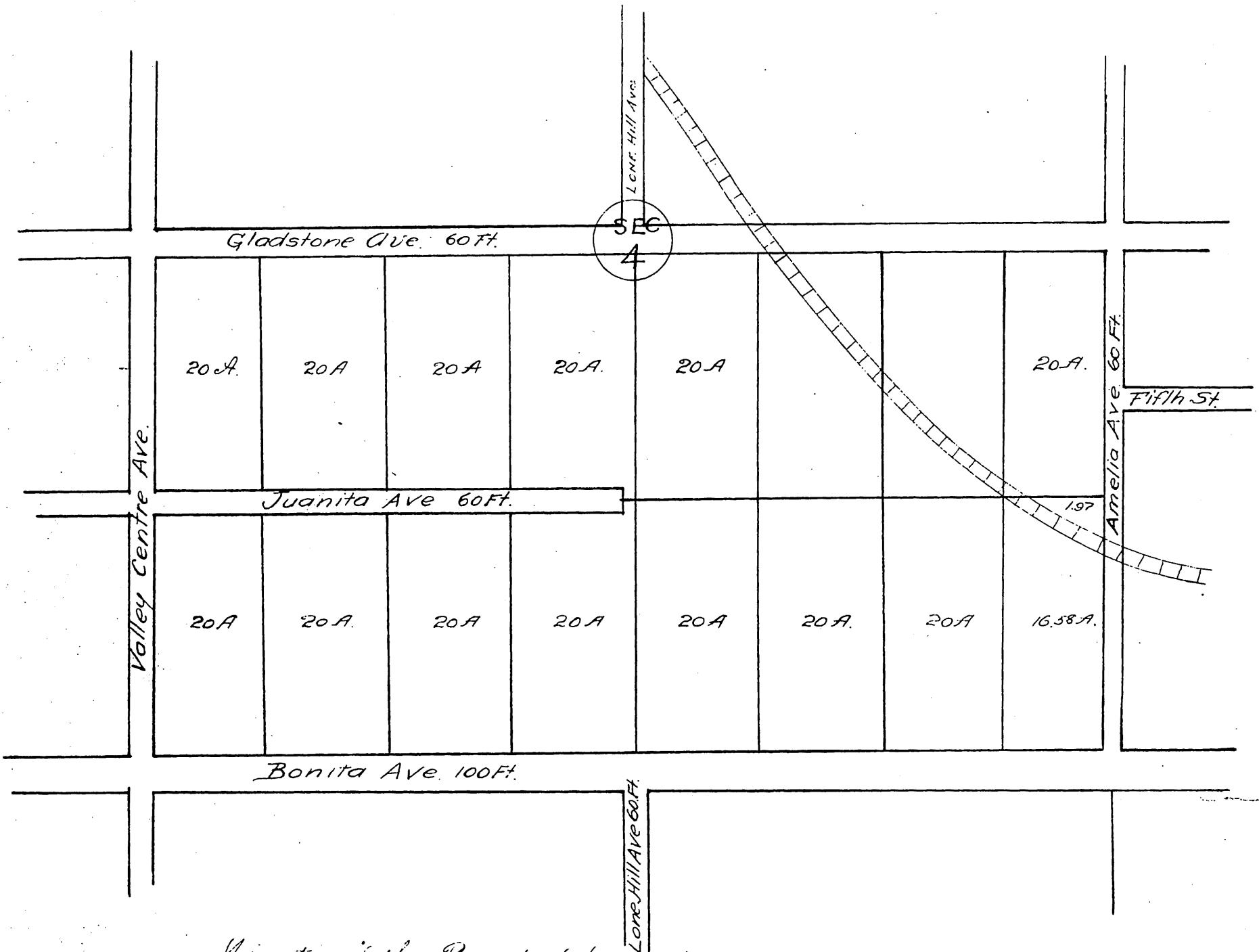


MAP

This matter having been presented on Feb
 ruary 2 1893, the Board taking the matter under advisement and having
 now duly considered the same, it was moved by Supervisor Ferrister,
 duly carried, ordered, that the prayer of the petitioners viz: Lone Hill
 Ave. between Gladstone Ave. and Bonita Ave. and Juanita Ave. between
 Lone Hill Ave. and Amelia Ave. be vacated and abandoned and the same
 returned to acreage and revert to the corners of adjoining and abutting
 acreage to be granted upon said petitioners filing with the County Recorder
 a Map showing such reversion.
