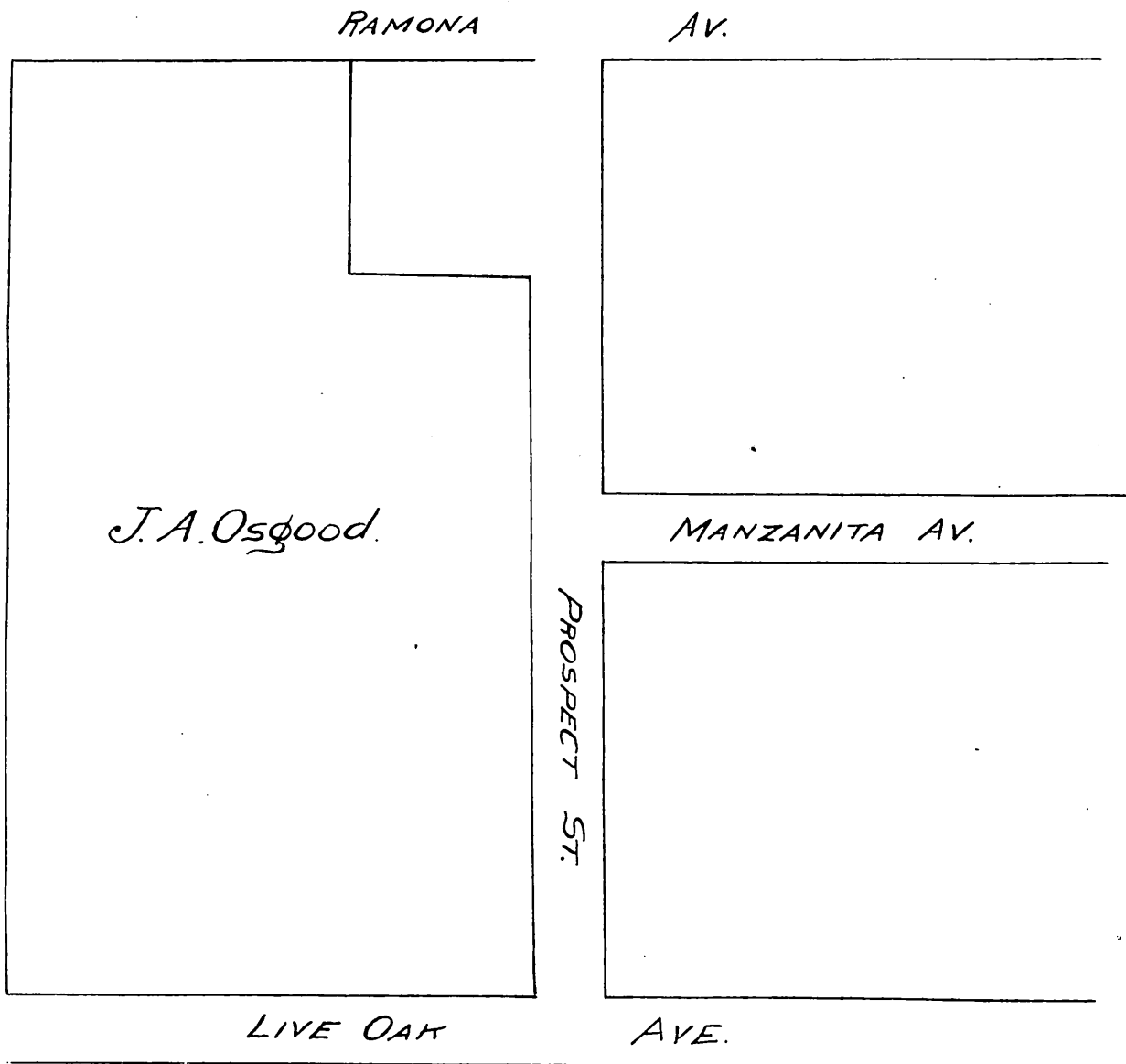

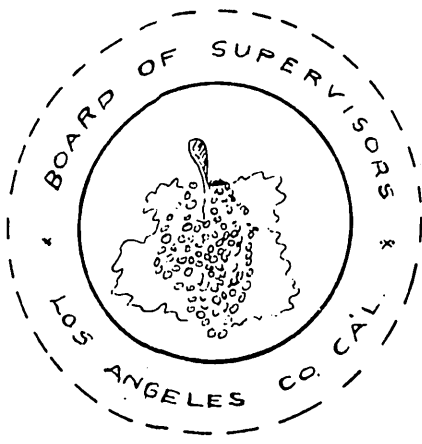
In Re Vacation of Manzanita Avenue  
and Reversion to Acreage Prospect Tract. }

This being the time duly set for hearing herein, the petitions are read, J. A. Osgood is sworn and testifies; and on motion of Supervisor Davis, duly carried, Ordered that the prayer of the petition be granted and the portion of Manzanita Avenue, as described in said petition, viz: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the intersection of the South line of said Manzanita Avenue with the West line of Prospect Street; thence west and along the South line of said Manzanita Avenue 465.39 feet; thence northerly 60 feet to the West line of Prospect Street; thence South 60 feet to the place of beginning, as shown, designated and delineated on a certain map of the Prospect Tract recorded in Book 14 at page 37 of the Miscellaneous Records of said Los Angeles County, and said Prospect Tract being a subdivision of Lot 3 of the Sierra Madre Tract, as shown in Book 4 at page 502 of said Miscellaneous Records, be and the same is hereby declared vacated and abandoned and that Lots numbered 49, 50, 51, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 85, 86, 87, 88 and 89 as shown be and are hereby abandoned to acreage property conditioned upon the petitioner filing with the County Recorder a Map showing such a reversion and vacation.
