

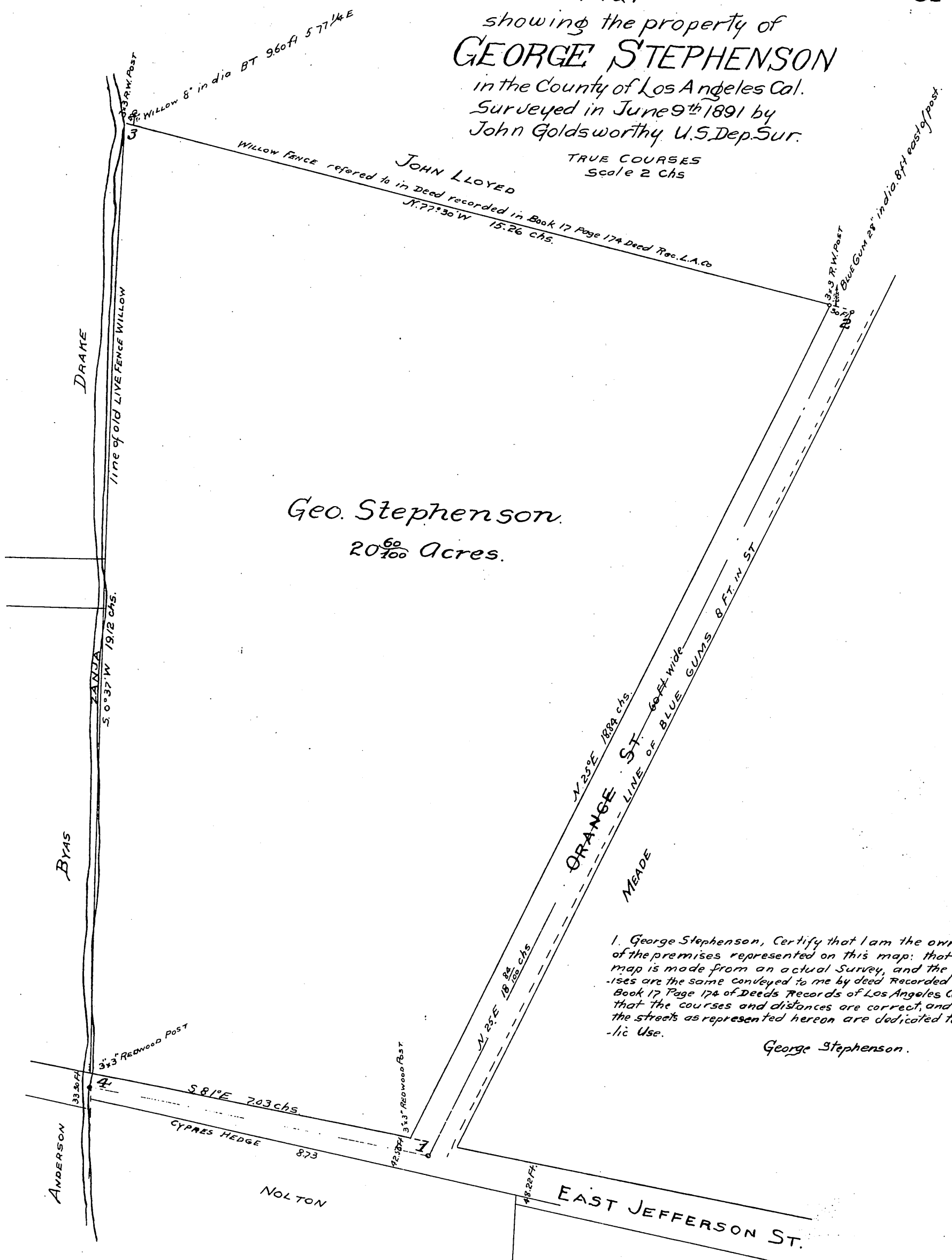
Plat
