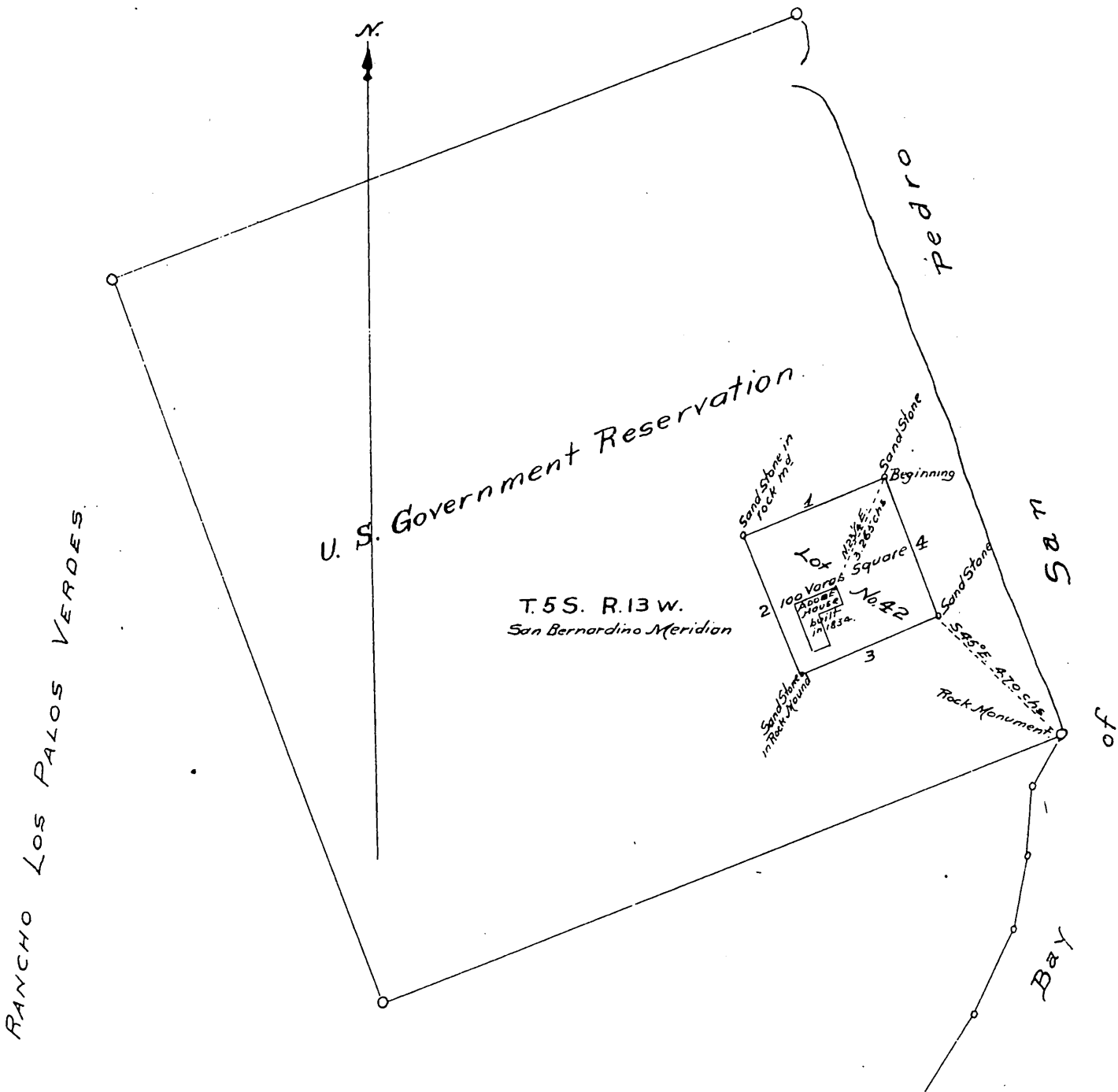


Map
