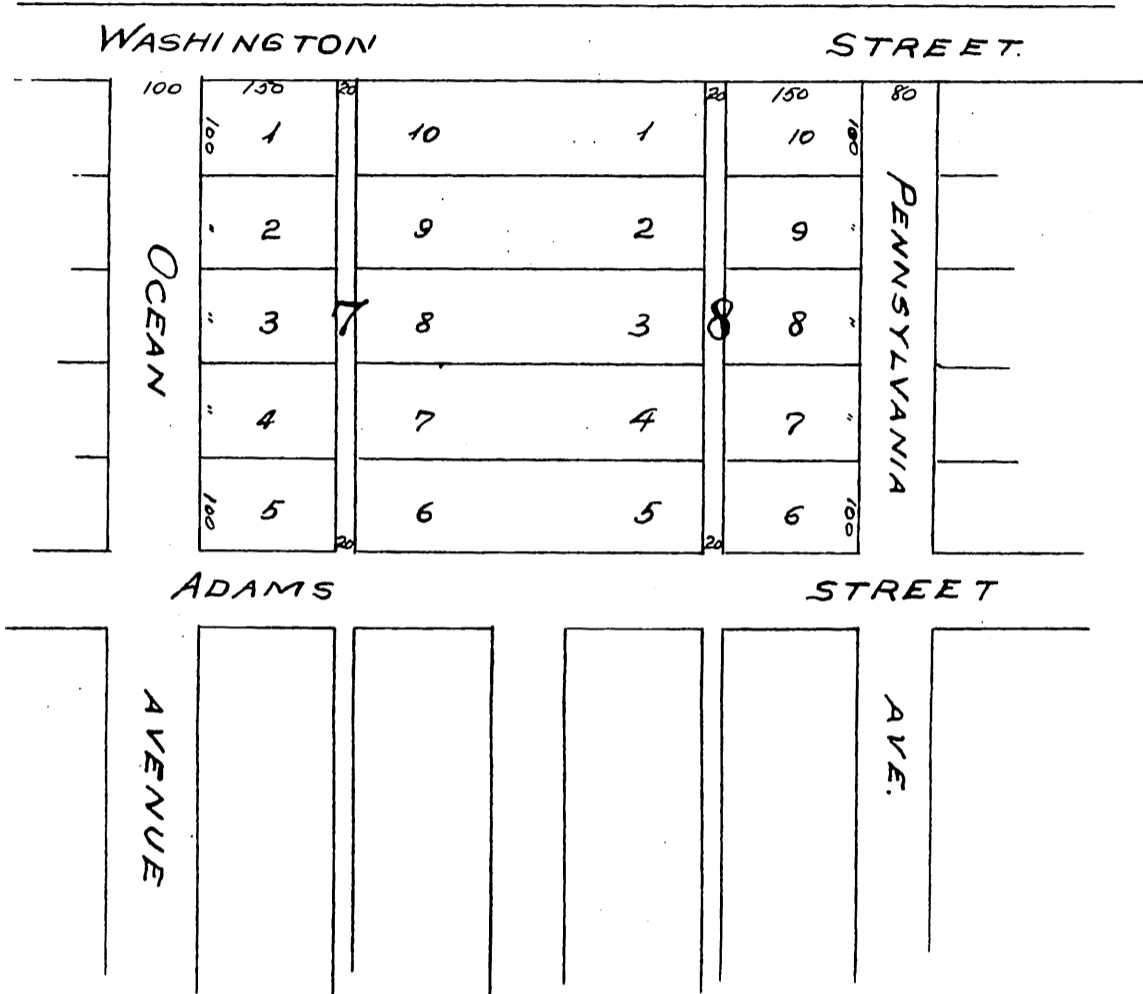


Map

IN RE VACATION OF STREETS }
CALIFORNIA AVE. (CLEARWATER) } This being the time reg-
ularly set by order of this Board for hearing herein,
S. A. Sharp and J. F. Millar are sworn and examined
and upon motion of Supervisor Day, duly seconded and
carried, it is ordered that "California Avenue from Wash-
ington Street to Adams Street in the Town of Clearwater,
as recorded in Book 19 of Miscellaneous Records pages 51, 52,
53 and 54" be and the same is hereby declared vacated and
abandoned upon the filing for record in the office of the
County Recorder of Los Angeles, ^{County of} of a map of all proper-
ty as affected by said vacation, reserving however the right
to reoccupy said property for road purposes whenever
the Board of Supervisors deems the same desirable, with-
out cost to the County.
