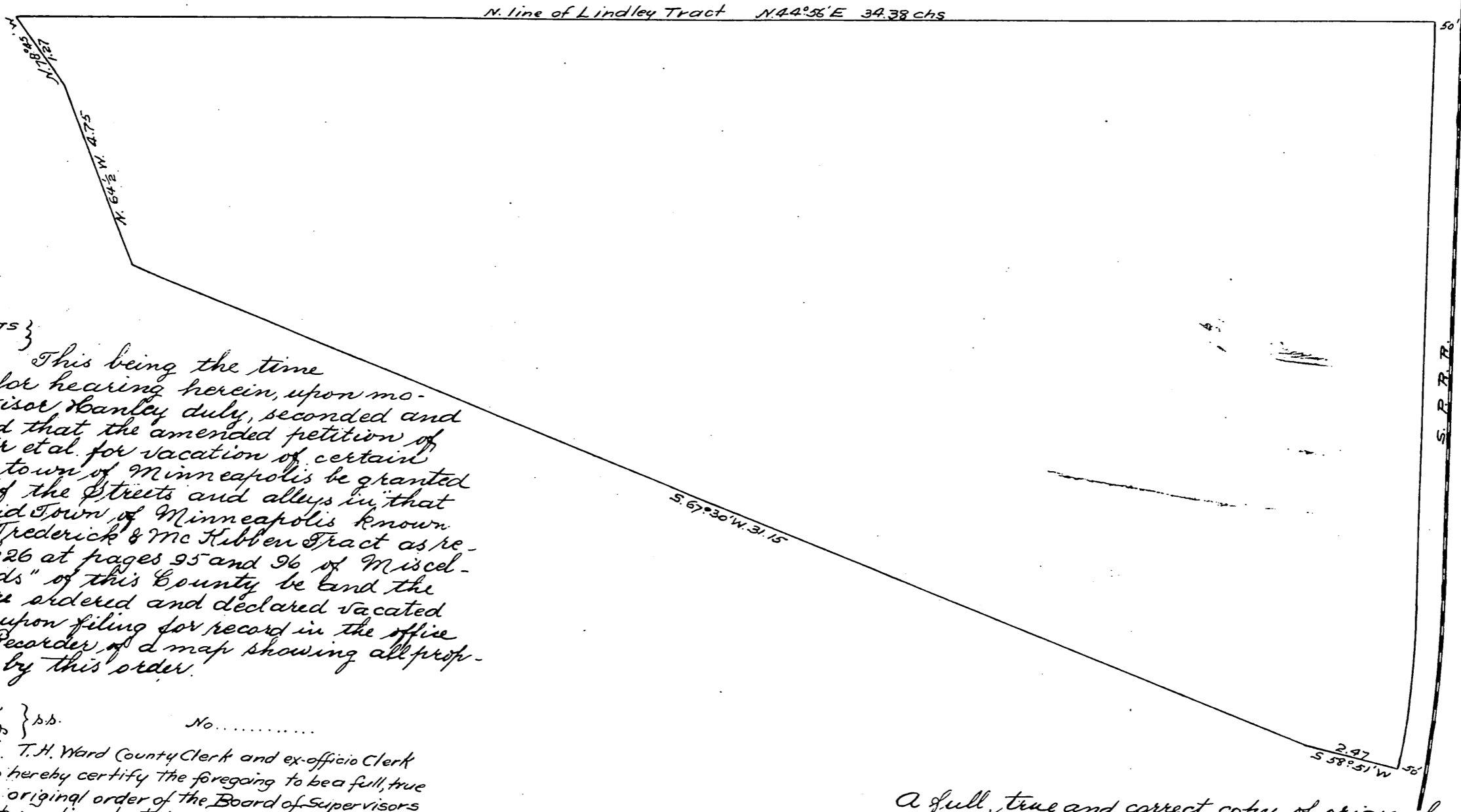


Map showing Vacation of Streets
