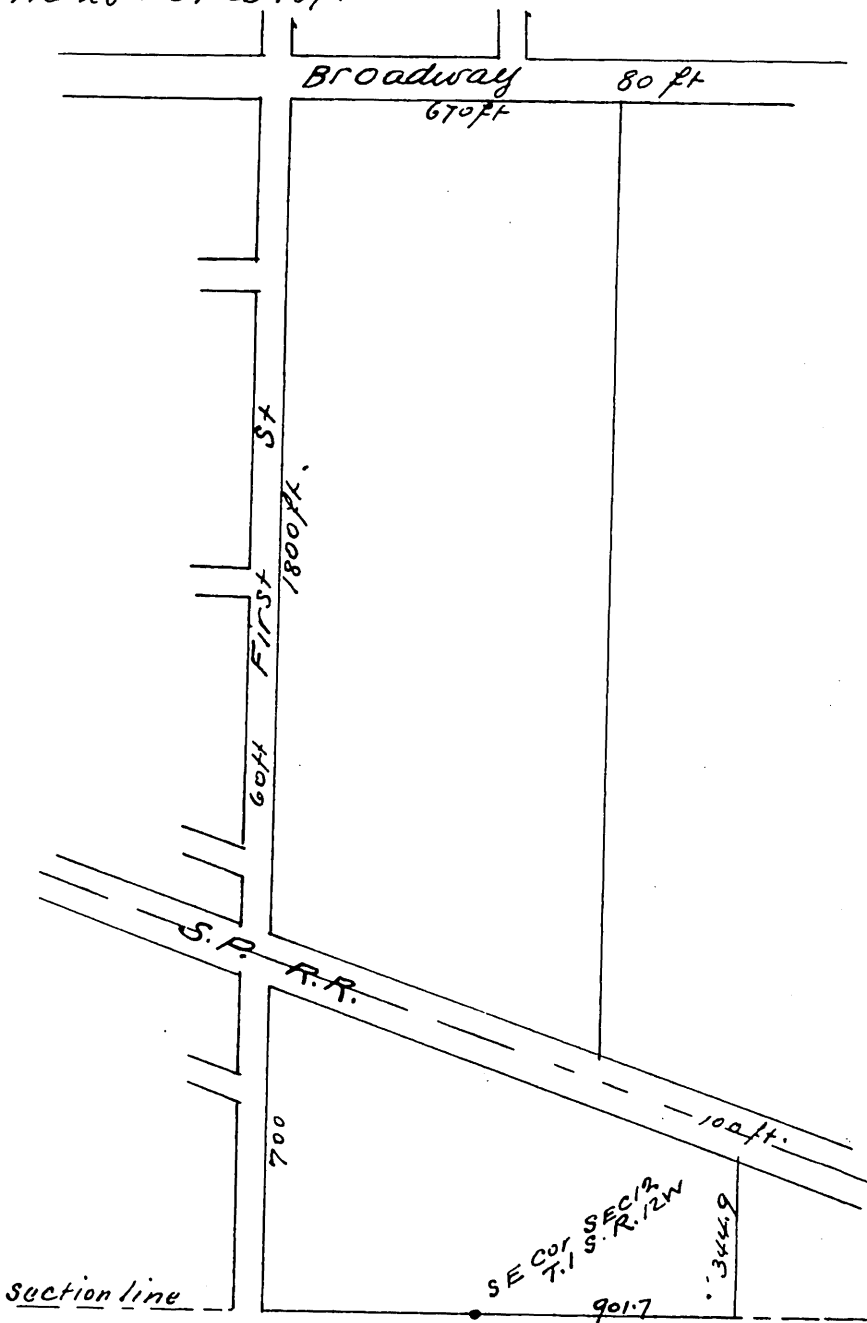

This matter having heretofore been taken under advisement pending a personal investigation upon motion of Supervisor Hay, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the Streets and Avenues as described and set forth in said petition viz: All of East Street running from Broadway to the Southern Terminus of said Street, all of Santa Fe Avenue from First Street to East Street; all of Commercial Avenue from First St to East St all of Angelino Ave from First St to its eastern terminus and all of Myrtle Ave from First St to its eastern terminus all of Blocks 45, 46, 47, 48, 49 and 50 in Sec 12, T. 1 S. R. 12 W. 3. B. M. and Blocks 126, 127, 128 and 129 in Sec. 7, T. 1 S. R. 11. W. S. B. M. (for further record see Book 21, Page 79 et seq Misc. Records, Recorder's Office) be and they are hereby declared vacated and abandoned and that the lots and block revert to acreage upon the filing in the office of the County Recorder of a map showing the property as affected by this order.
