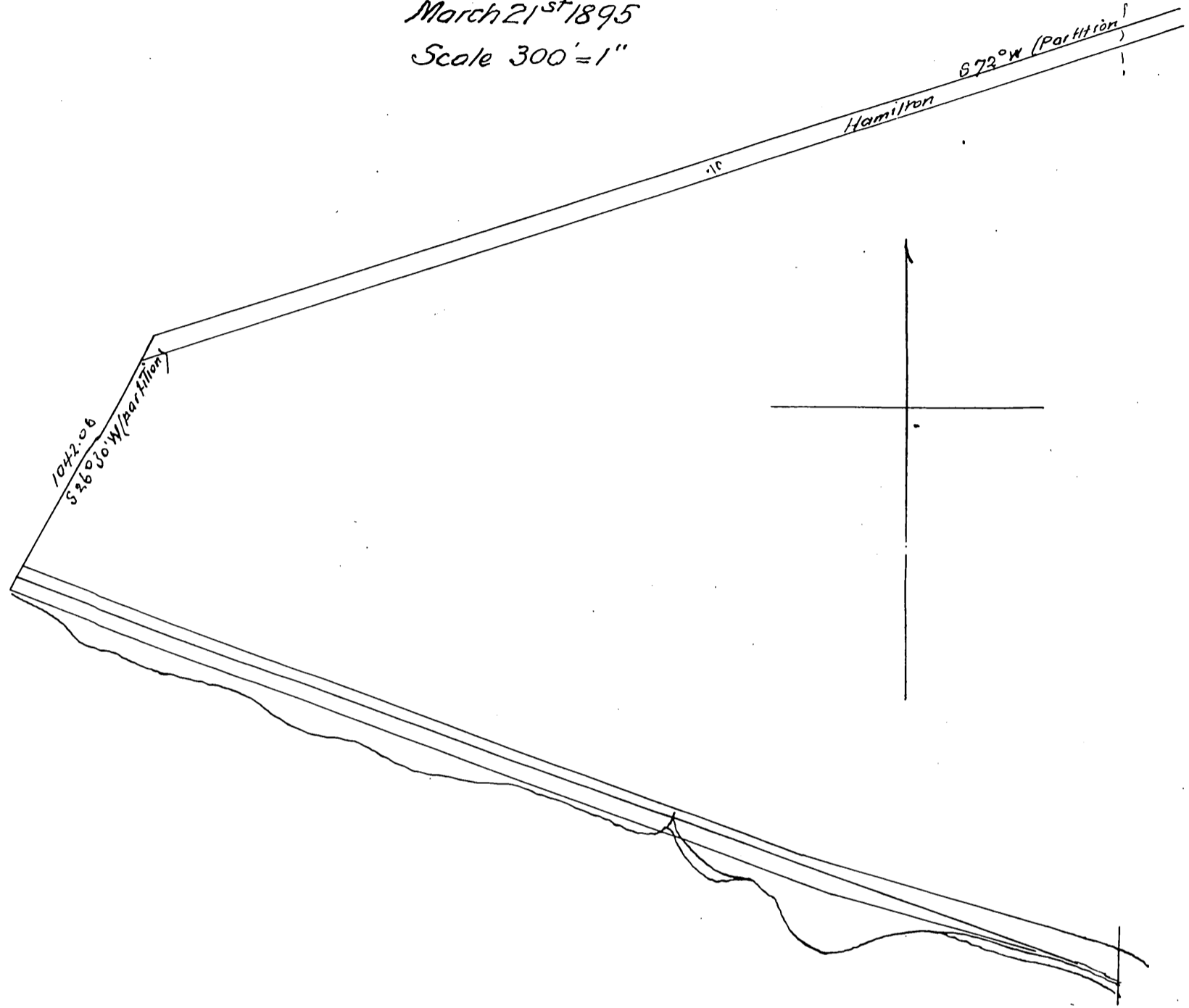

Adjourned meeting of the Board of Supervisors present the full Board & the Clerk

In re Vacation of all Streets Alleys and Roads and Reversion to Acreage of all Lots and Blocks in the Town of San Pedro Harbor

this being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition of Geo. H. Pack Jr et al for the vacation of all the streets, alleys and roads and the reversion to acreage of all the lots and blocks in the Town of San Pedro Harbor Aaron Smith agent for the owners of said town of San Pedro Harbor appears and is sworn and examined & protest against the vacation of all streets & roads in said town of San Pedro Harbor signed respectively by City of San Pedro, Merrick, Reynolds et al, and Roman D. Sepulveda et al, are presented and read, and R. D. Sepulveda and J. H. Dodson on behalf of Protestants are sworn and examined and F. J. Thomas Esq appears on behalf of the City of San Pedro and upon motion of Supervisor Hay duly seconded and carried it is ordered that the prayer of said petition be and the same is hereby granted except insofar as the same relate to the vacation of Hamilton Avenue and Pacific Avenue all of said Hamilton & Pacific Avenue being reserved, and it is further ordered that the same and there hereby is reserved by the County of Los Angeles any and all old roads within the boundaries of the tract of land described in said petition and now known as the Town of San Pedro Harbor the right which may have been acquired by said County by prescription This order is conditioned upon the filing by petitioner in the Office the County Recorder of a map showing all property as affected by this order
