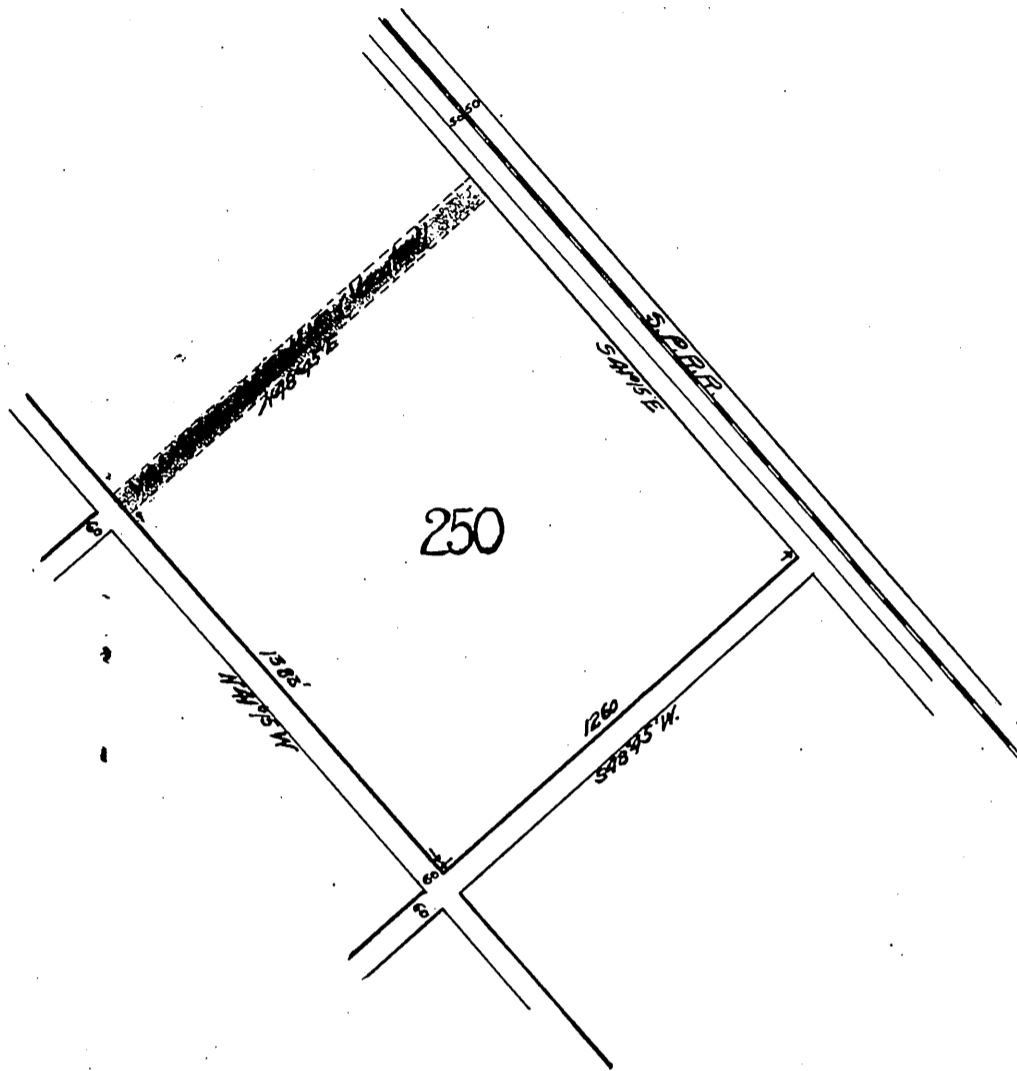

Adjourned meeting of the Board of Supervisors. Present the full board and the Clerk.

In re vacation of part of
Vaughn Avenue, MacLay Rancho }

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing herein, J. B. Scott, Esq., attorney for petitioner, appears and is sworn and examined, and no protests having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Hanley, duly seconded and carried it is ordered that so much of Vaughn Avenue as passes through the following described property, to wit: "Bounded by a line commencing at a point from which the East corner of Blk. 250 bears South 41 Degrees 15' E, distance 1011 ft.; thence along the highway N 41 degrees 15' W 657 ft.; thence S 41 degrees 15' W 1337 ft.; thence S 41 degrees 15' E 657 ft. thence N 41 degrees 15' E to point of beginning; containing twenty and 1/400 acres, as shown by the map and survey of this part of the Rancho Ex-Mission de San Fernando in Los Angeles Co., known as the MacLay Rancho," be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained revert to acreage upon the recording in the office of the Recorder of this County of a map showing all property as effected by this order.
