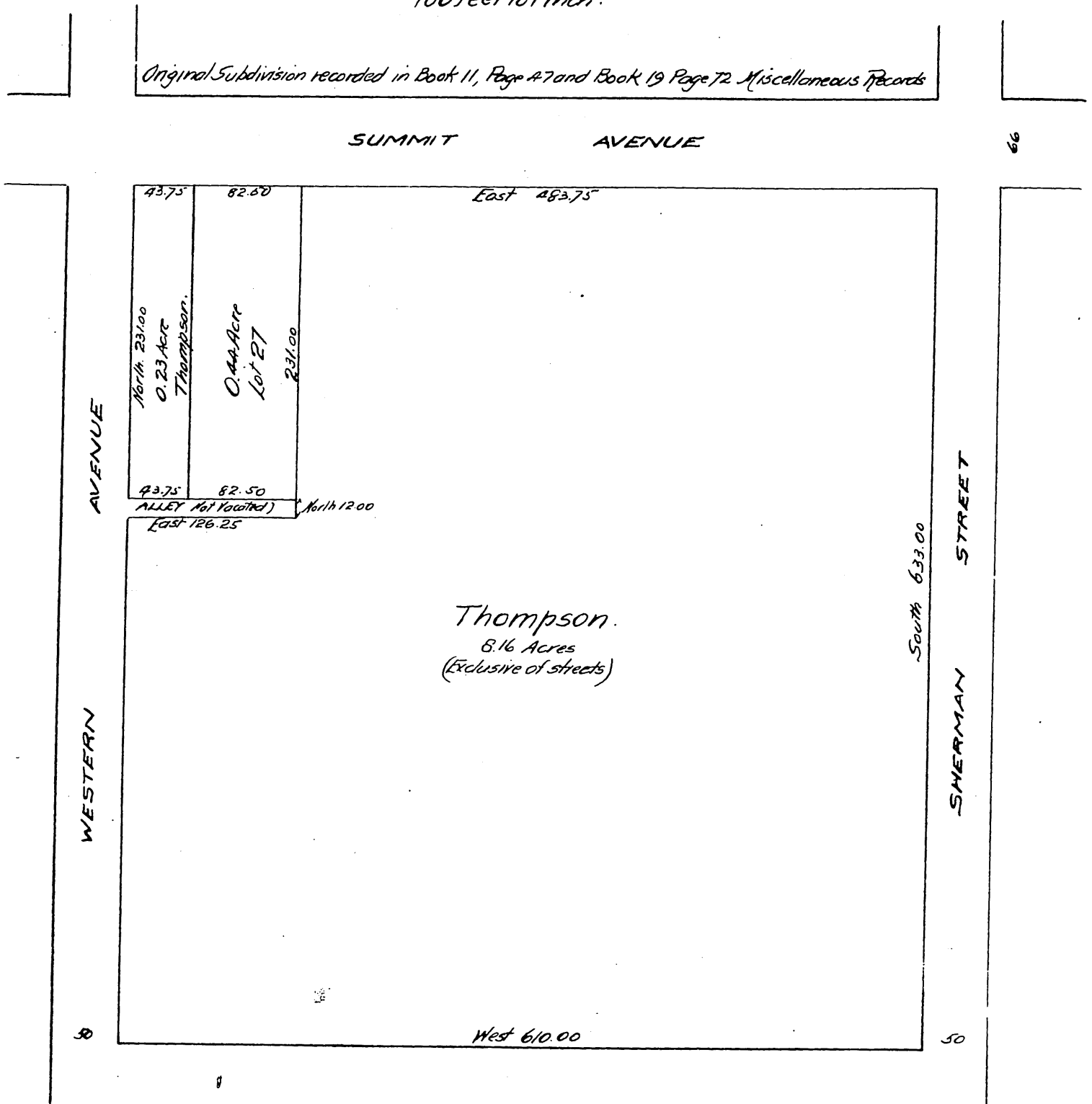

In re Vacation of Park Avenue and all alleys in Umpleby's Subdivision of N 1/2 of Lot 62 Monte Vista Tract } This being the time regularly set by order of continuance of this Board, for hearing the petition of O.D. Thompson, Sr, et al, for the vacation of Park Avenue and all alleys, as laid down on the tract of land in Los Angeles County, known as the Umpleby's Subdivision of the N 1/2 of Lot 62 of the Monte Vista Tract, in the Rancho Tejungo, a map of which tract is of record in Book 11, page 47, Miscellaneous Records of said County, S.A. Thompson appears and is sworn and examined, and no protest having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Hanley, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that Park Avenue and all alleys in said Umpleby's Subdivision (except that portion of the alley running from Western Avenue between Lots 27 and 29 and a portion of Lot 30 in said Subdivision) and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained is hereby restored to acreage conditioned upon the recording in the office of the County Recorder of a certified copy of this order attached to a map showing all property as affected by the same.
