July 31, 1895, at request of Robt, F, and Roy Jones agents for Senator J. P. Jones.

In re vacation of certain streets and alleys near Santa Monica

This being the time regularly set by order of Continuance of this Board for hearing in the matter of the petition of John P. Jones et al, upon motion of Supervisor Hay duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the prayer of petitioners be and the same is hereby granted and that Eighteenth Street, Nineteenth Street, and Twentieth Street, between Montana and Nevada Avenues, Twenty First Street, Twenty Second Street, Twenty Third Street, Twenty fourth Street and Twenty fifth Street, Idaho Avenue, north of the City Limits of Santa Monica, and California Avenue north of the City Limits of Santa Monica and Arizona and Utah avenues north of alley extending through Blocks 104 and 179, and all alleys running parallel to said streets north of Seventeenth Street between Montana and Nevada Avenues and all alleys running parallel to said streets north of Twenty first Street between Nevada and Railroad Avenues, all in the Town of Santa Monica, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained revert to acreage, and it is further ordered that a strip of land 20 feet wide along Twenty Sixth St from Rail Road Avenue to Nevada Avenue (in order to make that portion of the road conform to the part outside the City Limits) and a similar strip along the northerly side of 27th Street be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained revert to acreage, conditioned upon the deed to this County, free of expense, for road purposes, a strip of land one hundred feet wide running from Ocean Avenue to Canon Road and being a continuation of Ocean Avenue, also a strip of land sixty feet in width to be a continuation of Twenty seventh St to connect with a road on Mr Charnocks land and thus with the Boulevard, and upon the further condition of the filing in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, a map showing all property as affected by this order
