 At a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors present the full Board and the Clerk  
 1700 Vacational Streets and Alleys  
 and the Restoration of Vacated Lots  
 in Curry and Curtis Tract.

This being the time now set by order of this Board and judicial notice taken of the hearing  
 the Petition of Joseph J. Ruffery for the vacation of certain streets and alleys and the restoration  
 of vacated lots in the Curry and Curtis Tract as per map thereof recorded in the office of the  
 Recorder of Los Angeles County California in Book 10 of Miscellaneous Records Page 15 m.l. Ruffery appears and is sworn and  
 examined and no protest against the granting of said petition having been filed upon motion of Supervisor Hanley, duly seconded and  
 carried it is ordered that Randolph Street, Park Street, Des Moines Avenue and another 14 feet in width running between  
 Santa Anita Avenue and Des Moines Avenue, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and all the lots and blocks  
 in said Curry and Curtis Tract, together with the land contained in said vacated streets and avenues are hereby restored to  
 acreage conditioned upon the filing for record by the petitioner in the office of the Recorder of said County of a certified copy  
 of this order attached to a map showing all property affected by the same.
