

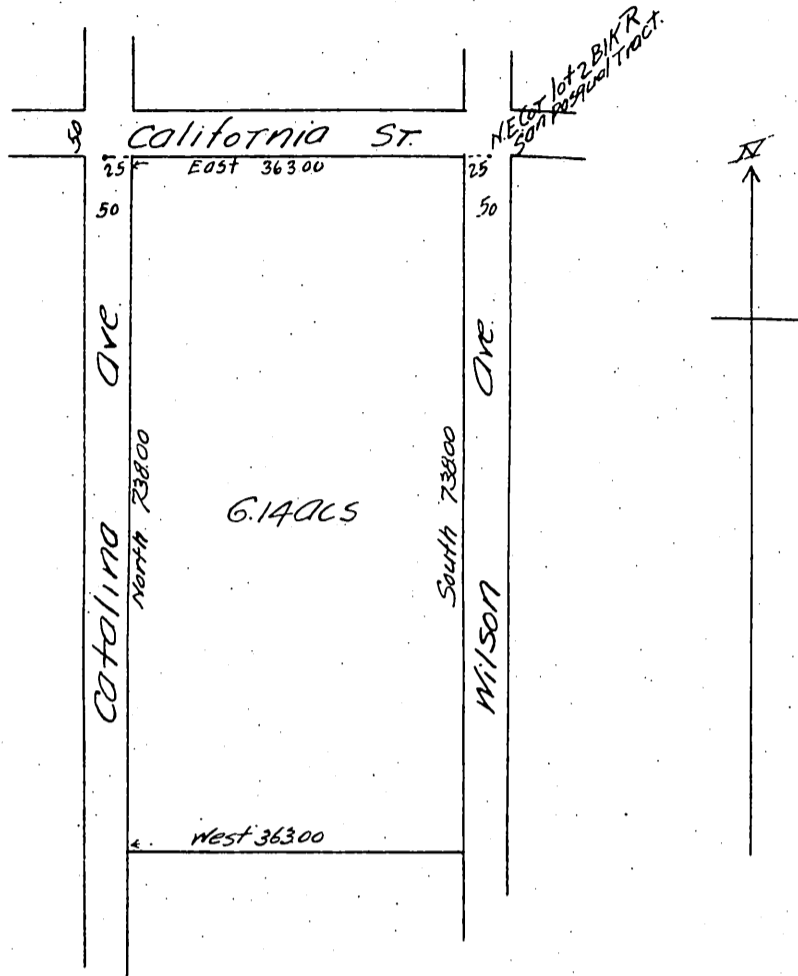
Live Oak Tract

Inte Restoration to acreage
of lots and vacation of an alley

The Petition of Mrs Margaret A. Mitchell, et al, for the restoration to acreage of the Live Oak Tract, being a part of Block R in Rancho San Pasqual, as per map recorded in Book 23, Page 18, of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County California, said tract consisting of twenty one lots numbered from one to twenty one, both inclusive and one alley, is presented and read and upon motion of Supervisor Field, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that said lots numbered from one to twenty one, both inclusive, and said alley in said Live Oak Tract, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained, restored to acreage, Conditioned upon filing for record by petitioners in the office of the County Recorder, of Los Angeles County, California, of a certified copy of this order attached to map showing all property effected by said order.
