On motion of SUP Davis the following petition was granted subject to filing of an amended map with the Recorder.

Los Angeles Cal, Jan'y 17, 1890.

To the Hon Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles Co, Cal,
Gentlemen

Your petitioners respectfully ask your honorable body to vacate all of Dor Ave, Ocean View Ave, and Linden Place, also that portion of War Ave, which lies between Prospect Ave and Sunset Boulevard, also all of the alley lying between Salma Ave, and Sunset Boulevard, all of said avenues and alley are situated in Hollywood, as per map recorded on pages 59 & 60 in Vol 28 of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles Co, Cal, and your petitioners further state, that said roads and alley are not necessary for the accommodation of the public, that they are not now, nor ever have been used as streets and alley, and that your petitioners are the only persons, in any way interested in said avenues and said alley, and your petitioners will ever pray, E.C. Hurd, H.H. Milcox, Harry Kitchen by H.H. Milcox his agent, Rev. Blondeau, Fernando Sepulveda, Geo T. Gomer, Henry Clausson, W.P. Wilson, J.W. Henry, W.H. Carlin, M. Lohary, Richard H. Williams, Edward S. Baker, M.R. Hurd.
