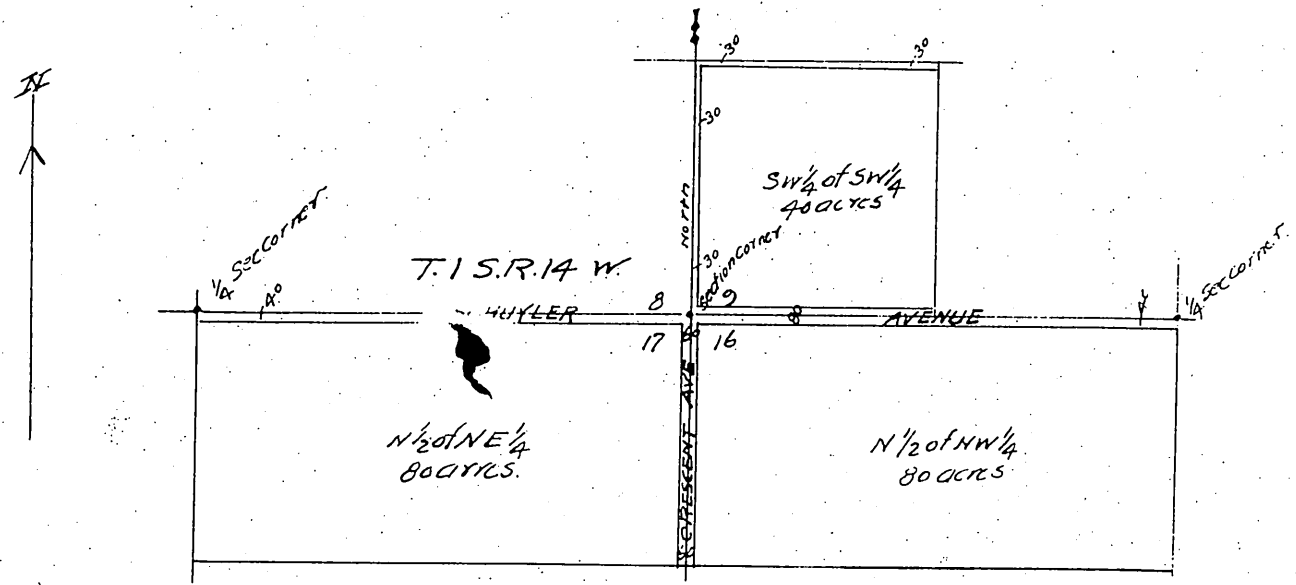




A part of the

 This being the time regularly set by order of this Board for hearing the petitions of Stephen Hagenbach and Johanna Hagenbach <sup>and K.C. Hagenbach</sup> and K.C. Hagenbach appears and is sworn and examined, and no protest having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Field, duly seconded and carried, the following is declared adopted.  
 Resolved that the petitions of K.C. Hagenbach, Stephen Hagenbach and Johanna Hagenbach, asking for the vacation of certain streets and alleys in the townsite of Cahuenga as shown on a map of said subdivision recorded in Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County Book 36, pages 11 to 12, be granted as follows, the vacation of all the streets and alleys in said subdivision south of Huyler Avenue, excepting Crescent Avenue which is to remain a sixty foot road through the lands of all the said Hagenbachs, and on condition that said Hagenbachs give ten feet additional off of the north side of their property, aligning what is now known as the Santa Monica Fairhill Road, formerly Huyler Avenue, or enough to make forty feet on the south side of this section line in the center of said road, and upon the further condition that petitioners herein file with the County Assessor and record in the office of the County Recorder a map showing all property affected by this order.

 This matter having been heretofore and on the 23rd day of September 1896 taken under advisement, and coming on at this time to be heard, upon motion of Supervisor Field, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the lots, blocks and alleys lying within the SW 1/4 quarter of Sec. 9, T. 1 S. R. 14 W. S. B. M. be and the same are hereby vacated and the land therein contained restored to acreage, and it is further ordered that Laurel Terrace, Orade Place, Arlington Avenue, Franklin Avenue and Crescent Avenue East in said, above described forty acres be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land contained therein restored to acreage conditioned upon the following to this County free of cost by the said petitioners viz I.H. Wilson and Karl Hagenbach of the following described strips of land for road purposes, viz. 1st Enough land off the southern side of said 40 acres to make Schuyler Avenue, or the Santa Monica Fairhill Road forty feet wide, northerly from the center line of the same, 2nd Enough land off the northern side of said 40 acres to make Fountain Avenue 30 feet wide from the center line of the same 3rd Enough land off the westerly side of said 40 acres to make Crescent Avenue, 30 feet wide from the center line of the same, and upon the further condition that the petitioners herein file for record in the office of the Recorder of this County a certified copy of this order attached to a map showing all property affected by the same.
