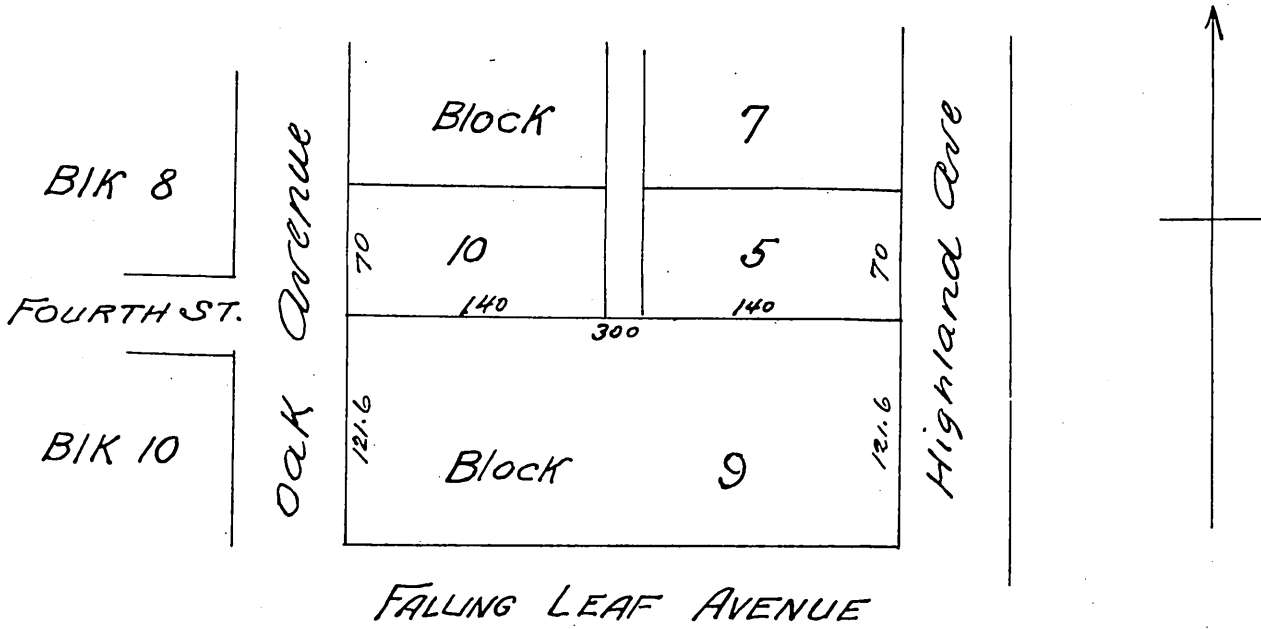


Map

In re vacation of a portion
 of 4th Street in Duarte

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board & publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition of Wm Crippendale, et al, herein, Wm Crippendale appears and is sworn and examined, and no protest having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Hawley, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered, that all that portion of Fourth Street in the Townsite of Duarte, as per map recorded in Book 19 page 62, Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, California, between Oak Avenue on the West and Highland Avenue on the East a distance of 300 feet more or less, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, upon filing, by the petitioners in the Office of the Recorder of Los Angeles Co, California, of a certified copy of this order attached to a map showing all property as affected by the same
