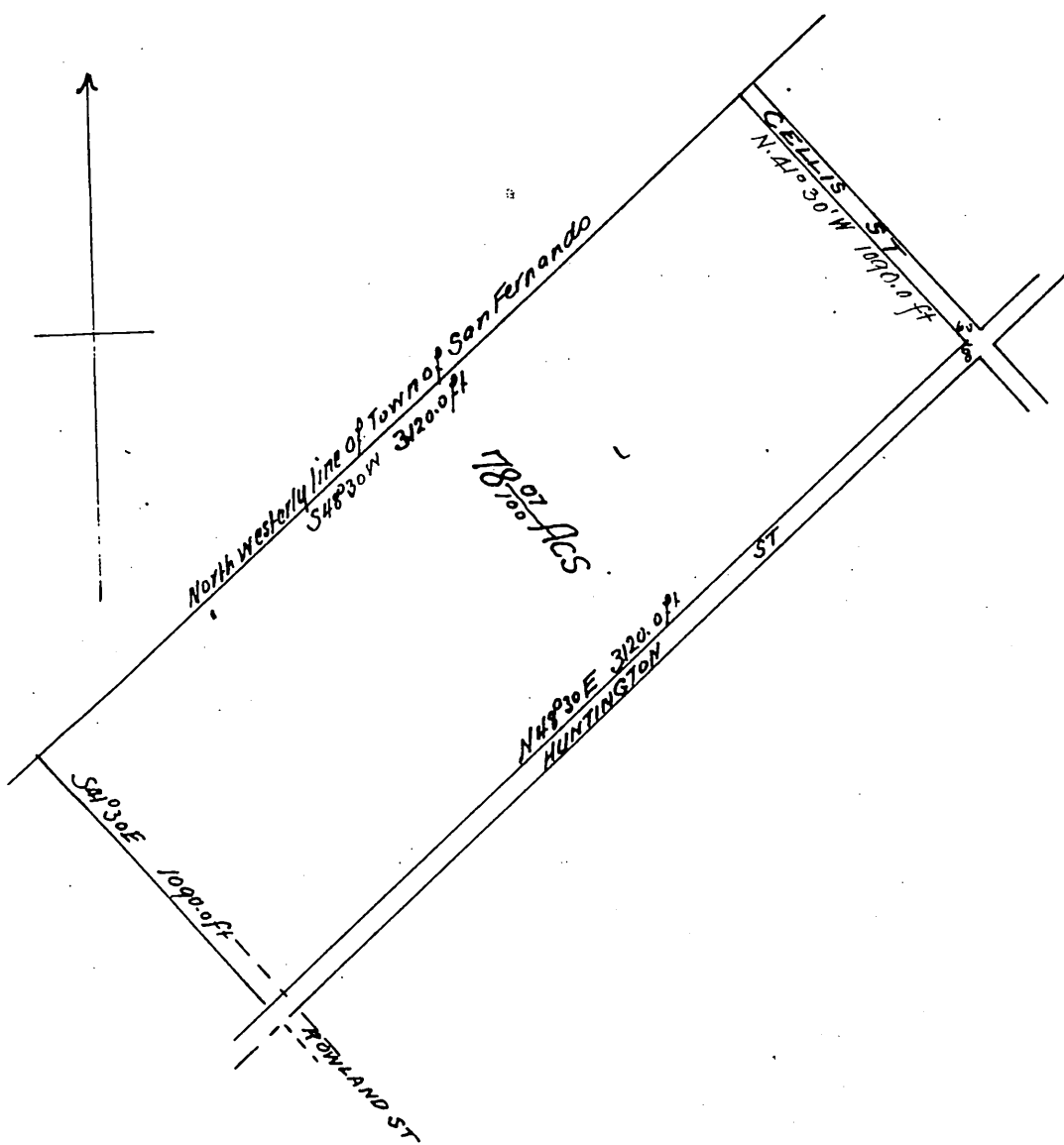


Vacation of a portion of the

In vacation of certain streets
 in Town of San Fernando

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition of Porter Land and Water Co, et al. herein J.B. Threlkeld, appears and is sworn and examined, and no protest against the granting of said petition having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Stanley, duly recorded and carried it is ordered that all of those streets and parts of streets lying North West of the Northwesterly line of Huntington and Southwest of the Southwesterly line of Cellis Street, in said Town of San Fernando, recorded in Book 2 of General Land Office Records of Los Angeles Co, Cal; at page 591 et seq and named Cazart, Mayer, Pico, Connel, Hollister, Hewitt, Kewen, Griffith, Mott, Woodworth, O'Melveny, Widney, Sepulveda and Rowland Streets, &c and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained is hereby restored to acreage conditional upon the filing for record by petitioners, in the Office of the Recorder of said Los Angeles Co, of a certified copy of this Order attached to a map showing all property as affected by the same.
