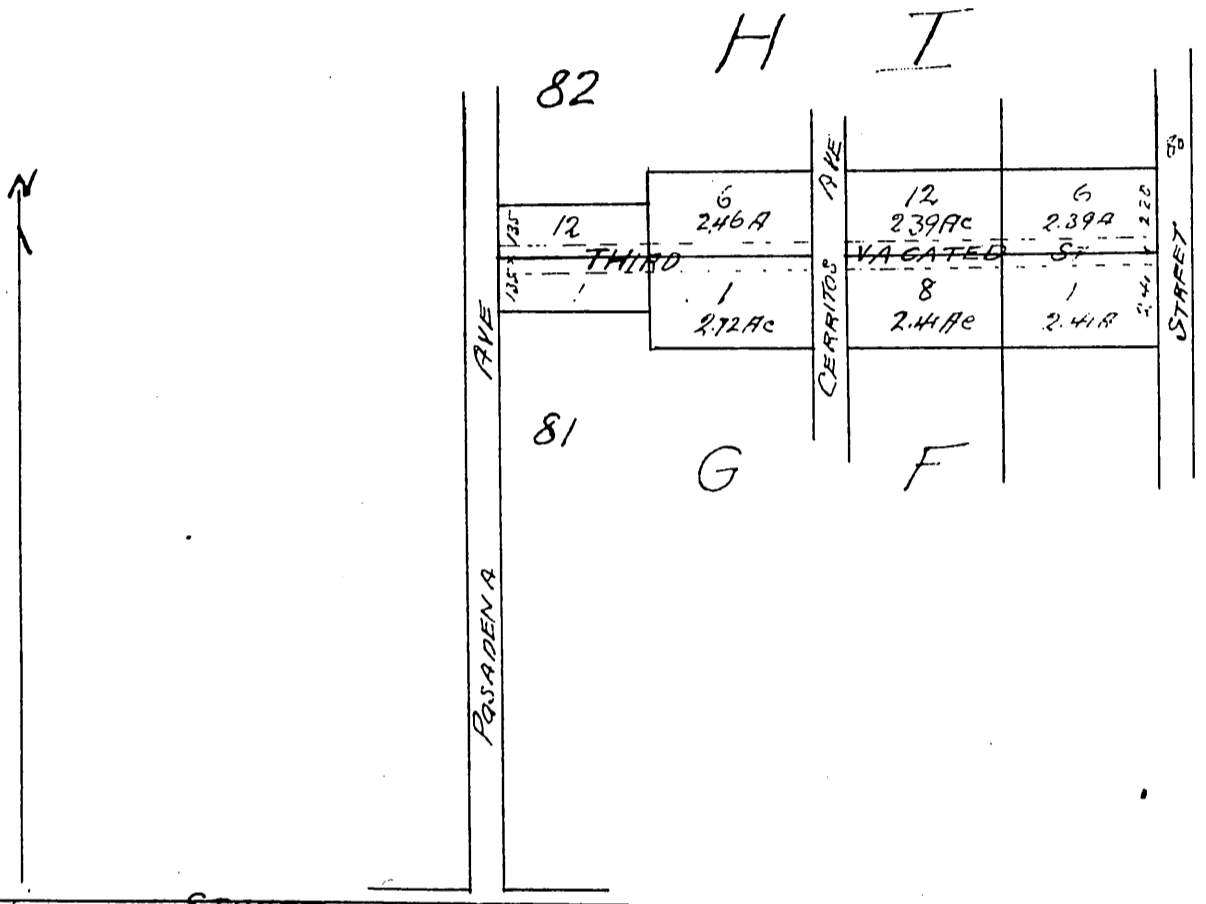


# Map showing vacation of Orange Ave & Third Street through lands of

Stawson appears and is sworn and examined and in protest having been filed upon motion of Supervisor Forrester duly seconded and carried it is ordered that Third Street between Pasadena Avenue and the East line of the lands of the Azusa Land and Water Company in the Townsite of Azusa and on map of Subdivision One of Lands of the Azusa Land and Water Company be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained revert to acreage upon the filing in the office of the County Recorder of maps showing all property as affected by this order.
