



In re Vacation of Certain Streets }
in the Town of Inglewood }

A petition from D. Freeman and 9 others, freeholders, and two of whom are residents in

Centinela Road District, is presented and read as follows, to wit:

"That Whereas the main travelled road from Los Angeles to Inglewood is, on account of natural obstacles, diverted from the dedicated road allowance and runs across private property through Block 302 of the Town of Inglewood;

And Whereas, the owner of the said Block 302; Grace E. Howland, is willing to convey a strip of land sixty feet in width, for road purposes across said Block, provided that a portion of certain streets, which are not used, be abandoned in lieu thereof;

Now therefore, your petitioners pray that the following streets in the Town of Inglewood, according to the map thereof recorded in Book 34, pages 19 to 35 of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be vacated and abandoned, to wit:

Los Angeles Street from the west line of Redondo Avenue to the East line of Locust Street, and the westerly eighty feet of Redondo Avenue from the north line of Regent Street to the southerly line of Inglewood Avenue and from the northerly line of Inglewood Avenue to the southerly line of Los Angeles Street. And that a road sixty feet in width be established across said Block 302 where the road is now graded, and be dedicated as a public road"

And upon motion of Supervisor Davis, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that said petition be and the same is hereby granted, and that the following described streets or portions of streets, to wit: Los Angeles Street from the West line of Redondo Avenue to the East line of Locust Street, and the westerly eighty (80) feet of Redondo Avenue from the north line of Regent Street to the southerly line of Inglewood Avenue, and from the northerly line of Inglewood Avenue to the southerly line of Los Angeles Street, as shown on a map of the Town of Inglewood, recorded in Book 34, at pages 19 to 35 of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, conditioned upon the filing for record in the Office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, by the petitioners, of a certified copy of this order attached to a map showing all property affected thereby: and also the filing with this Board of a good and sufficient deed from Grace E. Howland to the County, for Road purposes, of the strip of land sixty feet in width, now used and graded as a road, across Block 302 of the Town of Inglewood.
