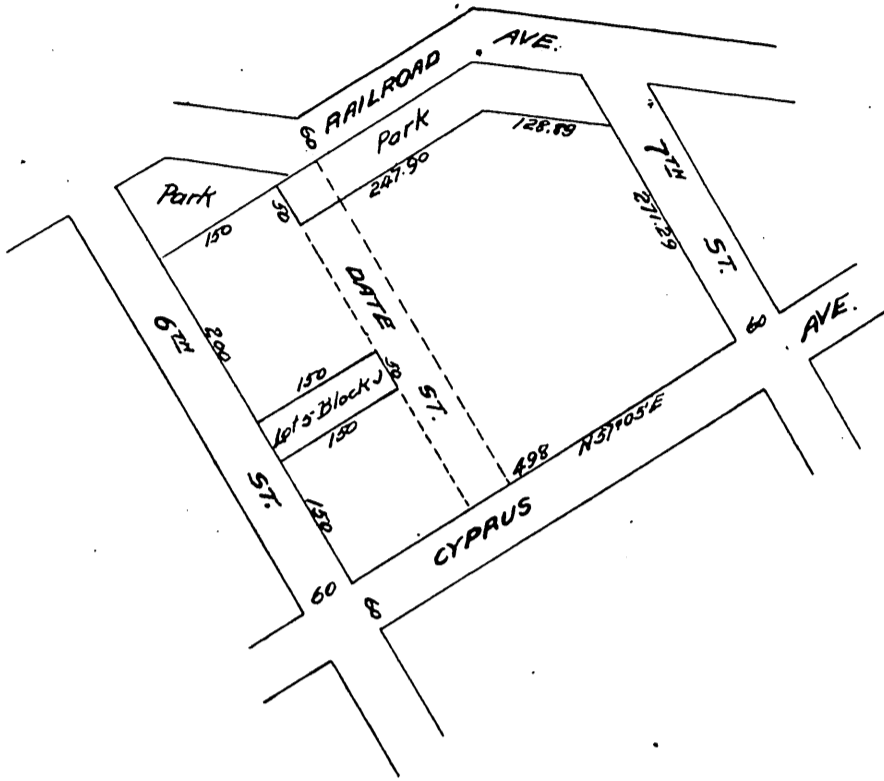




# Replat of part of Block J of "The Palms" Showing vacation of Date St.

In re Vacation of Date Street,  
in the Palms.

A petition from Daniel Moriarty and 22 others, residents and taxpayers of "The Palms", is presented and read, asking the Board to vacate and ordain to throw back into acreage a certain street, to-wit: a strip of land called Date Street, as shown on a plat recorded in Book 23, Page 11, Miscellaneous Records of said Los Angeles County, California. Said Date Street commences at Cypress Avenue; thence runs Northerly across Block "J" to Railroad Avenue, being between Sixth Street and Seventh Street in "The Palms". Said Date Street having never been opened, graded or travelled, and Daniel Moriarty was sworn and examined in regard to the facts set forth in said petition; and upon motion of Supervisor Davis, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that said described Date Street commencing at Cypress Avenue and running Northerly to Railroad Avenue between Sixth Street and Seventh Street in "The Palms," as shown on a plat recorded in Book 23, Page 11 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, California, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein described restored to acreage, upon the condition of the filing for record, by petitioners, in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, California, of a certified copy of this order attached to a map showing all property as affected by the same.
