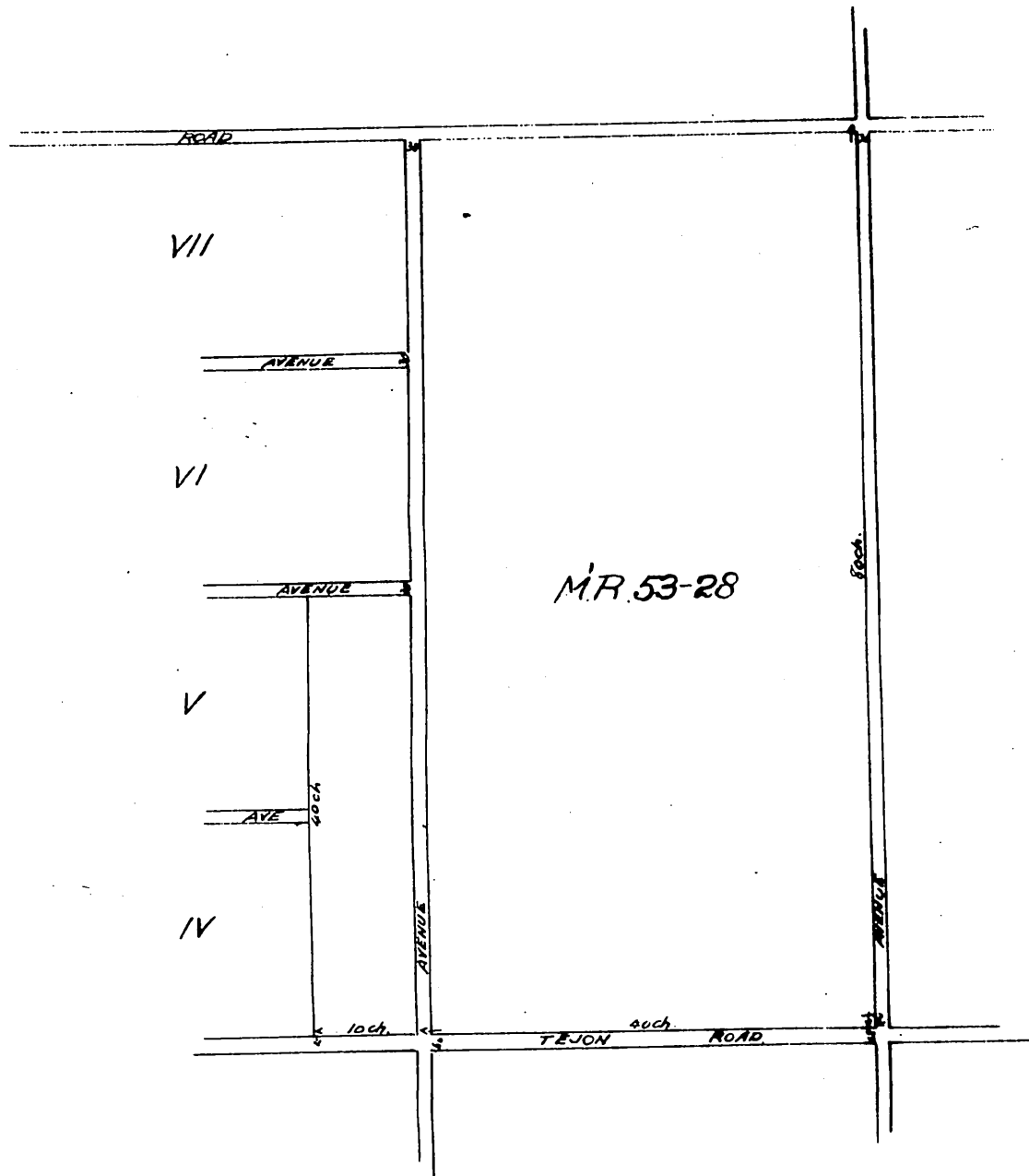

*In re Vacation of Streets }
 Manzana Colony Lands }* This being the time regularly set by order of this Board for the continuation of the hearing of the petition of E. A. Silvey, et al, for the vacation of certain streets, avenues and lot subdivisions in the Manzana Colony Lands, as described in said petition, the same is taken up and a letter is presented and read from John A. Covert, Road Foreman of the La Liebre Road District, within which said streets and roads are situated, stating that they had never been used as roads, and that the County did not need them; and upon motion of Supervisor Hanley, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that said petition be, and the same is hereby granted; and it is further ordered and declared that certain streets or avenues in the East one-half of Section twenty-four, Township 8 North, Range 16 West, S.B.M., and in the East one-half of the East one-half of the S.W. 1/4 of the same section, which are now described as Blocks VIII, IX, X and XI, Lots 1 and 8 of Block V, and Lots

1 and 8 of Block 4 of Manzano Colony Lands said Streets being described as follows;

All that portion of a certain street or avenue running East and West, and bounded on the North by Block VIII and on the South by Block IX of said Manzano Colony Lands;

All that portion of a certain street or avenue running East and West, and bounded on the North by Block IX and on the South by Block X of said Manzano Colony Lands;

All that portion of a certain street or avenue running East and West and bounded on the North by Block X and on the South by Block XI of said Manzano Colony Lands.

All that portion of a certain street or avenue running East and West and bounded on the North by Lot 8 Block V and on the South by Lot 1 Block IV of said Manzano Colony Lands.

All as shown on a map recorded in Book 53 at Page 28 of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage, and any offer of dedication of said streets or avenues made by the filing of said map, is hereby refused, it appearing to this Board that said streets have not been used by the public, and that they are not required for the use of the public.

This order is conditioned upon the filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, California, by the petitioners of a certified copy of this order together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
