Plummer appears and is sworn and examined, and upon motion of Supervisor Forrester, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that Wilson Avenue from Patti St. to Ampara Ave. be and the same is hereby declared vacated and abandoned, and it is further ordered that Ampara Avenue be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned reserving however the right as to Ampara Avenue to re-occupy said avenue for road purposes whenever the Board of Supervisors deem the same desirable without cost to the County; and it is further ordered that Fountain Avenue be and the same is hereby reduced from an eighty foot avenue to a forty foot street between Plummer Street to Ampara Avenue, the order to take effect upon the filing in the office of the County Recorder of a map showing all property as affected by this order.
