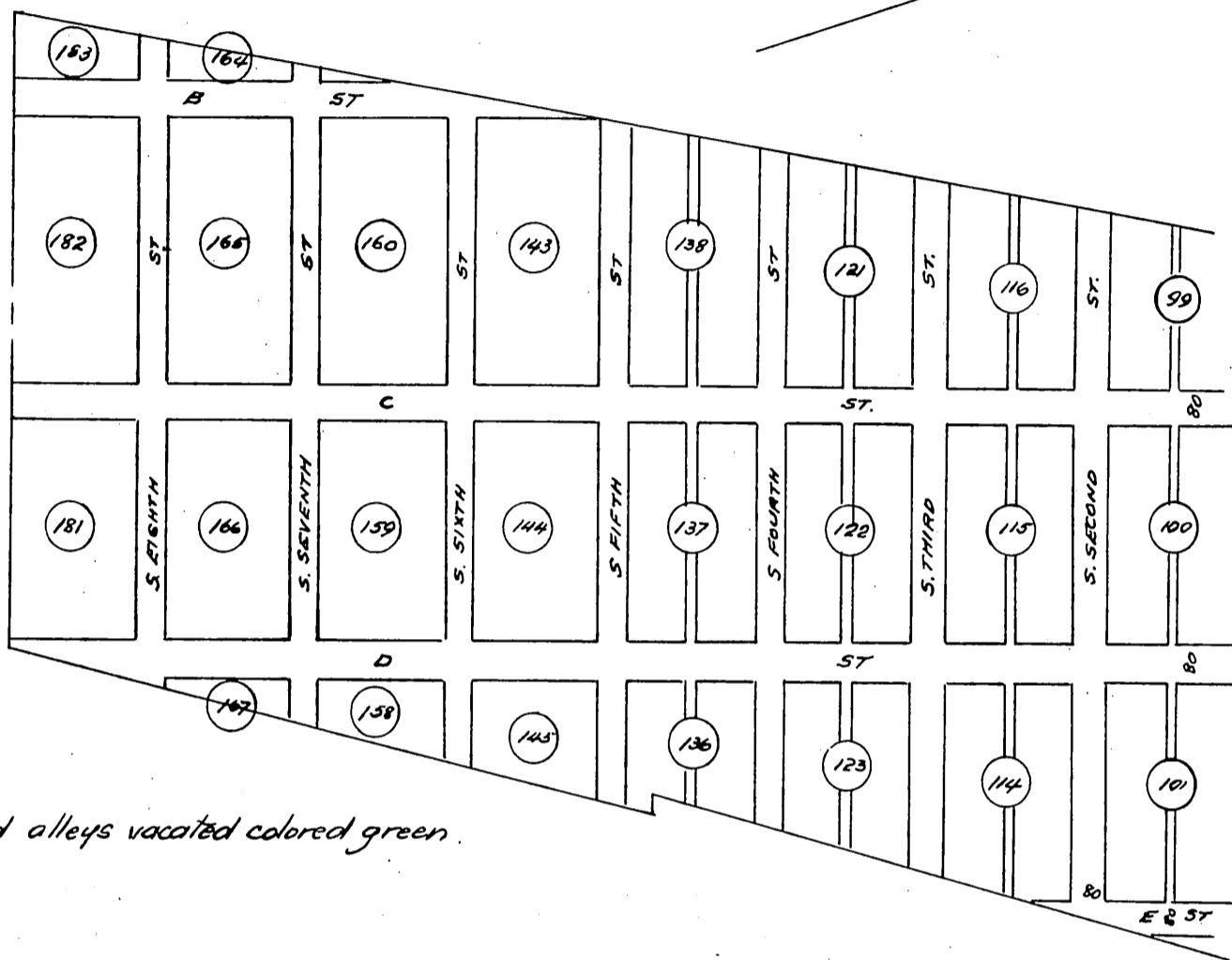


# MAP

In re Vacation Streets and Alleys  
in Lordsburg

This being the time regularly set by  
order of this Board, and publication of  
notice thereof, for hearing the petition of W. H. Atkinson, et al, herein, W. Theiser  
is sworn and examined and no protest against the granting of said petition hav-  
ing been filed;

Upon motion of Supervisor Longden duly seconded and carried  
it is ordered that the prayer of said petition be and the same is hereby grant-  
ed and it is further ordered that.

All the streets and alleys in the townsite of Lordsburg, lying south  
of South Second Street and easterly of the easterly line of that part of Lordsburg  
as vacated by action of the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County July 11<sup>th</sup>  
1890 as shown at page 257 in Road Book #3 and on map recorded in the County  
Recorder's office in Book # 42 page 34 Miscellaneous Records and being:

All that portion of B Street south of South Second Street not heretofore va-  
cated by action of the Board of Supervisors.

All of C Street south of South Second Street.
