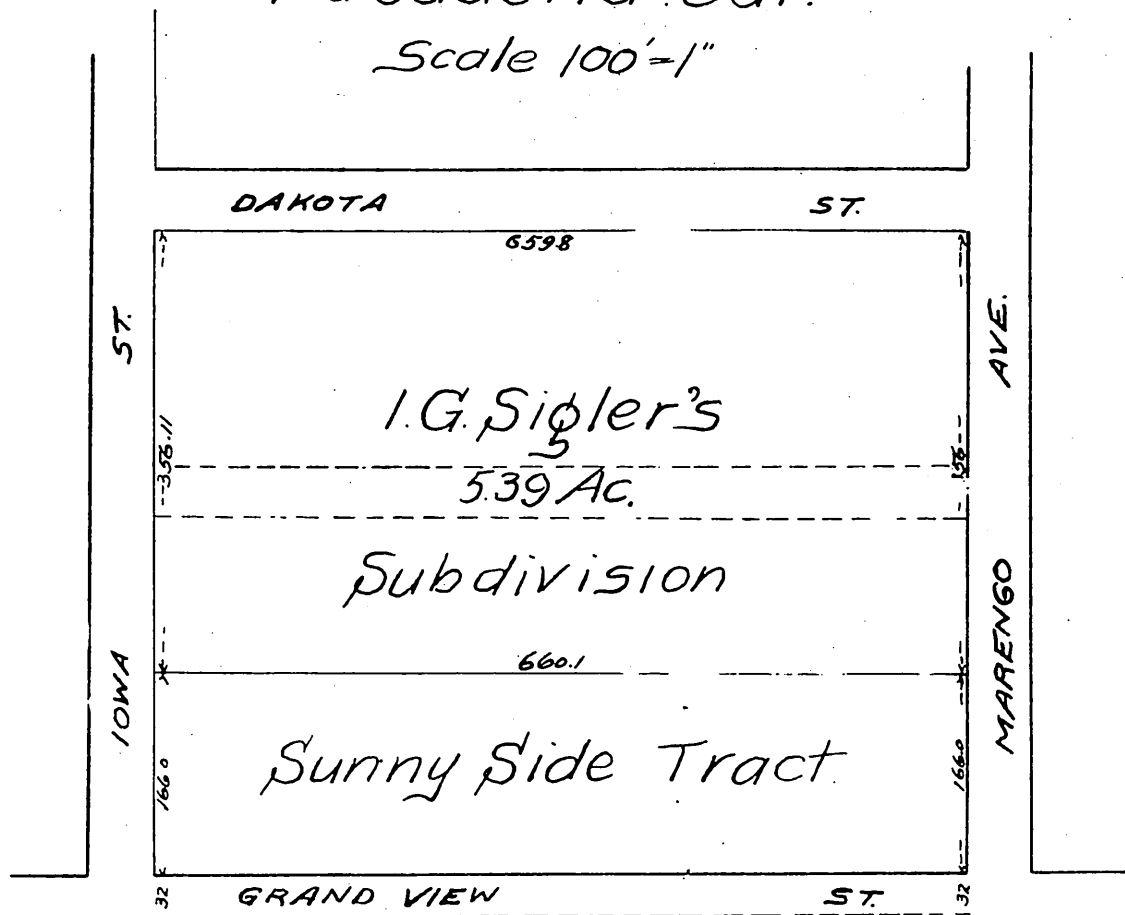


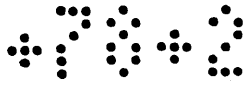
Map showing vacation of

In re Vacation of  
Golden Terrace Avenue )

North Pasadena ) A petition from M. D. Painter and 15 others, residents and  
freeholders in the Pasadena Road District, within which the street to be vacated lies,  
is presented and read, asking the Board to discontinue and close Golden Terrace Street  
(Avenue), and stating the following facts:-

That the said street extends from Iowa Street easterly a distance of one block to  
Marengo Avenue, and that all the property fronting on both sides of said street is own-  
ed by M. C. Wentworth and James C. Hamlen, two of the petitioners,

That the said street is not used by the travelling public, and no property is af-  
fected thereby excepting only the property fronting thereon;

That the said owners of said property are desirous of improving the same as  
one block or parcel and cannot do so unless the said street be closed;

That the closing of said street will not entail any expense upon the County."

A letter from Joshua Wood, Road Foreman of said District, is presented and  
read, stating that said street had never been opened for travel, and to open it would  
be a detriment to surrounding property;

Upon motion of Supervisor Hanley, duly seconded and carried, it is order-  
ed that said petition be, and the same is hereby granted; and it is further ordered and  
declared that Golden Terrace Avenue, between Iowa Street and Marengo Avenue, as shown  
upon a map of I. G. Sigler's Subdivision of the Nly 5 1/2 Ac. of Block 'N' of the Subdivided  
lands of J. H. Painter and B. F. Ball, as recorded in Book 22 at page 85 Miscellaneous Rec-  
ords of Los Angeles County, California, be, and the same is hereby vacated and abandon-  
ed, and the land therein contained restored to acreage, and any offer of dedication  
of said street made by the filing of said map, is hereby refused, it appearing to this  
Board that said street has not been used as such by the public, and that it is not  
required for the use of the public.

This order is conditioned upon the filing for record in the Office of the Re-  
corder of Los Angeles County, California, by the petitioners, of a certified copy of  
this order, together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
