




B.F. Porter Tract

In re Vacation of Streets and the Restoration to Government Subdivisions of Certain Property in Chatsworth Park

Upon motion of Supervisor Hanley, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the lots and streets lying in Section 36, T. 2 N. R. 17 W., S. B. M., and all the lots and streets lying in Section 25 and S. W. 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 2 N. R. 17 W., S. B. M., as shown by map of Chatsworth Park recorded in Book 30, page 91, Miscellaneous Records in County Recorder's office of Los Angeles County be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage, excepting from the above vacation the street along the north and east side of the S. W. 1/4 Section 24, conditioned upon the deed to the County, all interest B. F. Porter may have in Main Street between 2nd and 5th Street as shown on map in Book 1 of Surveys, Page 56 County Recorder's office, and also all right B. F. Porter may have for a right of way 60 feet wide adjoining and on the west side of S. P. R. R., through Sec. 30 T. 2 N. R. 16 W. S. B. M., (about 5 chains long) And upon further conditioned that the petitioner etc.

 B.F. Porter having petitioned
 the Board of Supervisors for a
 waiver of the conditions impos-
 ed by resolution of the Board found in Road Book No 5, page 230, passed
 August 11th, 1897,

Upon motion of Supervisor Harley, that the condition named in
 said resolution, to-wit: that B.F. Porter deed to the County of Los Angeles
 all the interest he may have in Main Street between Second and Fifth Streets
 as shown by map in Book 1, of the Surveys, page 56 of the County Record-
 er's office, is hereby waived. That the deed of B.F. Porter to the right of
 way 60 feet wide adjoining and on the west side of S.P.R.R., through Section
 30, T2 N. R. 16 W-5 B.M., about five chains long is also waived and that
 the streets ordered vacated in said resolution above named be vacated up-
 on the sole condition that the petitioner, B.F. Porter, file for record in the of-
 fice of the County Recorder a map showing the land in sections as revert-
 ed to acreage.
