

Upon motion of Supervisor Wirsching, duly seconded and carried it is ordered that the prayer of the petitioners be and the same is hereby granted. And it is further ordered and declared that Santa Cruz Street, First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Fifth Street, Sixth Street and Seventh Street, running west from Otis Street; and Walker Street and Mendell Avenue running from Seventh Street to Santa Cruz Street; also all the alleys in Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of said subdivision, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage, and any offer of dedication of said streets made by the filing of a map of said subdivision (May 9, 1899) is hereby refused.
