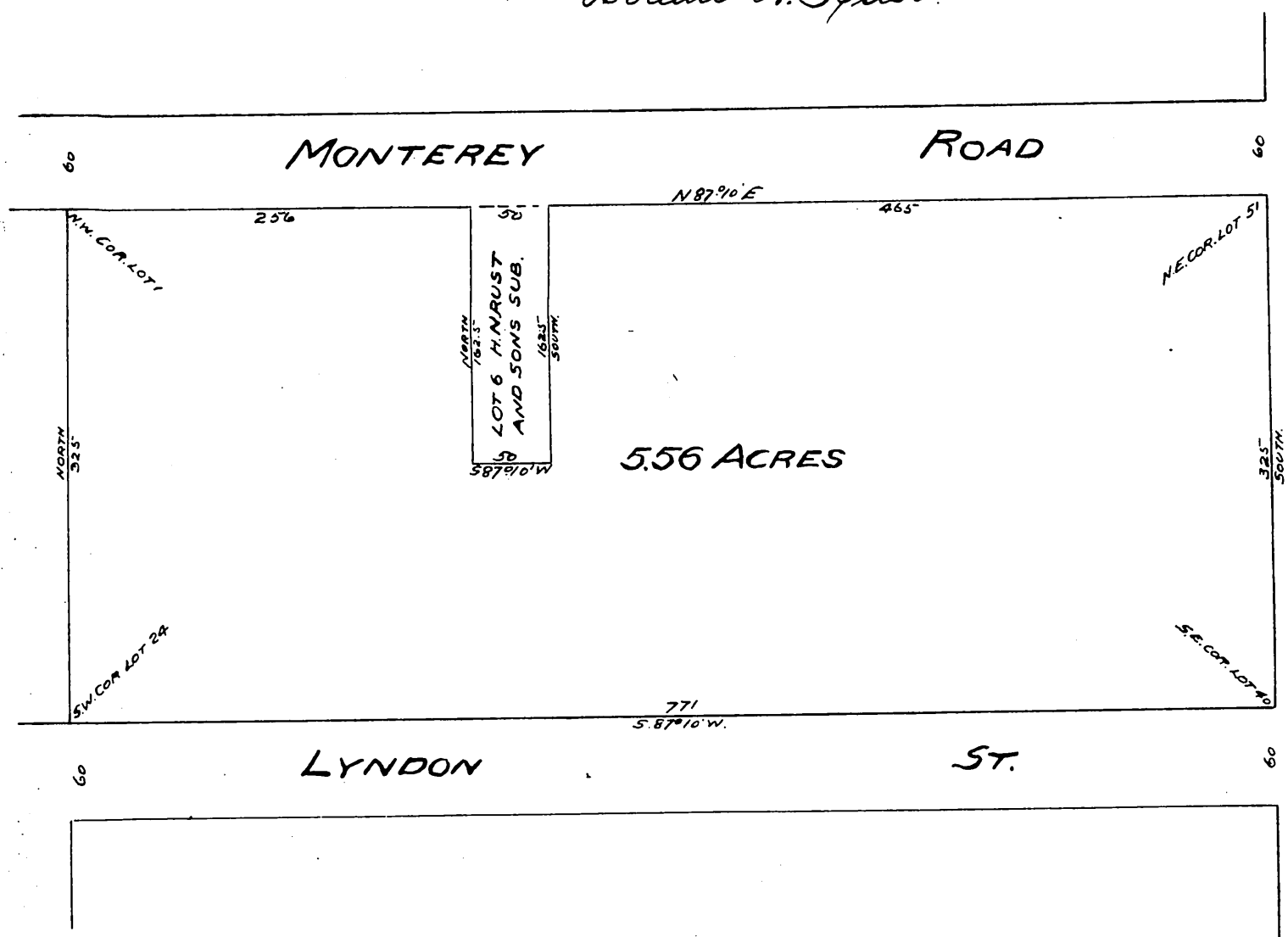


# H.N. Rust's Re-plat

A resolution refusing to accept the offer to dedicate for public use a certain alley in H.N. Rust's Subdivision and and consenting to the withdrawal of such offer.  
 Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of South Pasadena:  
 That whereas, on a map of H.N. Rust & Sons Subdivision recorded in Book 26, Page 16 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, there is shown a certain alley running from Monterey Road to Lyndon Street and lying parallel to and one hundred and fifty feet west of Fair Oaks Avenue;  
 And whereas, the offer to dedicate said alley made by recording said map has never been accepted, etc.  
 Therefore be it resolved by this Board of Trustees that the City of South Pasadena does hereby consent to the withdrawal of said offer to dedicate said alley and does hereby refuse to accept said offer.
