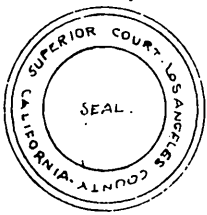
Upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the prayer of the petitioner be and the same is hereby granted, and it is further ordered that First Street east of H. Street; Second Street east of H. Street, all of First Street lying north and east of Pomona Avenue and south of Southern California R.R., excepting the intersection with H. Street; all of Second Street lying north and east of Pomona Avenue and south of Southern California R.R., excepting the intersection with H. Street; all of I Street south of Third Street and north of Pomona Avenue; all of J. Street south of Fourth Street and north of Pomona Avenue, excepting the intersection with Third Street;

And all the alleys in Blocks 45, 46, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88 and the east half of 89, all of 104, 105, 106, 107, 108 and 109 as shown on a map of the Townsite of Lordsburg, recorded in Book 18, pages 9 to 14 inclusive, be and they are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage, conditioned upon the filing for record by petitioners in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County of a certified copy of this order together with a map showing all property as affected thereby
