


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Section 10 T.1 S. R.9 W. SB.M.

The Board met in regular session pursuant to adjournment. Present Supervisors, A.E. Davis, Chairman presiding, E.S. Field, O.W. Longden, James Hanley and P.E. Whisching, and C.W. Bell, Clerk by R. Williams, Deputy.

In re Vacation of Part of
San Dimas Avenue, San Jose Road District.)
Petition of J.A. Johnstone, et al.)

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board, and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition of J.A. Johnstone, et al., for the vacation of a portion of San Dimas Avenue in the Town of San Dimas, by reducing the width of said avenue from 80 feet to 50 feet, the matter is taken up, and no protests having been filed;

Upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the prayer of the petitioner be and the same is hereby granted.

And it is further ordered that San Dimas Avenue, in the town of San Dimas, San Jose Road District, be and the same is hereby declared to be fifty (50) feet wide by vacating and abandoning fifteen (15) feet on each side of said avenue, and the land contained therein restored to acreage, conditioned upon the filing for record by petitioner in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County of a certified copy of this order together with a map showing all property so affected thereby.
