Cahuenga Valley Road District) The following petition is pre-

sented and read:

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors
Gentlemen, -

We the undersigned, resident free holders of
the Cahuenga Valley Road District, taxable therein for road purposes, here
by petition your Honorable Body to vacate and abandon as a public road
or highway the following described land to wit: All that portion of El-
wood Street lying southeasterly of Palm Avenue, as shown by colored
portion of accompanying map.

Signed by J. Quint, et al, (ten signatures)

Upon motion of Supervisor Field, duly seconded and carried
it is ordered that the following be and the same is hereby adopted.

Whereas, on June 20th 1899 H.H. Sherman, Leander J. Quint
and James D. Shaffer deeded to Los Angeles County a strip of land for
the extension of Palm Avenue in the Town of Sherman; and

Whereas, it is represented to the satisfaction of this Board that the
extension of Palm Avenue was intended to take the place of that portion
of Elwood Avenue asked to be vacated; therefore be it

Resolved, that the said petition be and the same is hereby granted;
and it is further ordered and declared that the said Elwood Street describ-
ed in said petition be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned
and the land therein contained restored to acreage, and any right of
this County acquired by the use of said street is hereby relinquished
This order is made in consideration of the deed executed by Le-
ander J. Quint, H.H. Sherman and James D. Shaffer and accepted by
this Board on June 20th 1899; and this order is further conditioned
upon the filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Ang-
eles County, California, by petitioners of a certified copy of this
order together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
