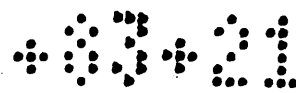


Plat showing

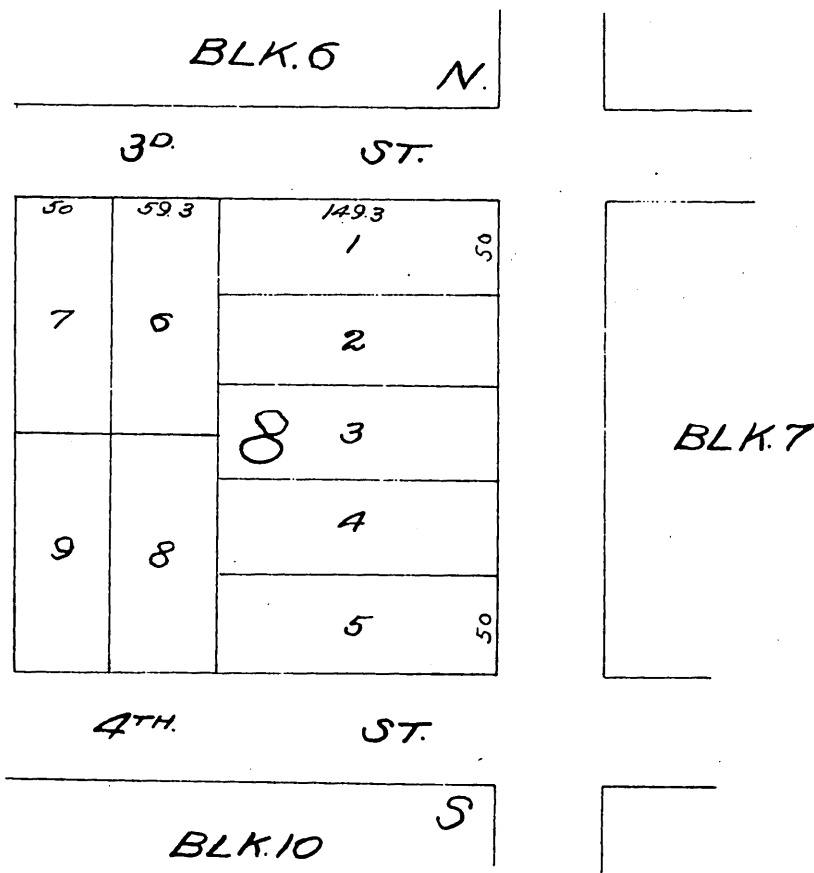

In re Vacation of Alley in Block 8, Town of Duarte }

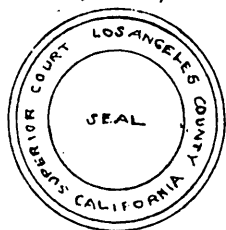

Clapp is examined, and no protest against the granting of said petition having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor London, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the prayer of the said petition be and the same is hereby granted, and it is further ordered that all of that certain alley lying and being in Block 8, Town of Duarte, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage conditioned upon the filing for record by petitioners in the office of the Recorder of said County of a certified copy of this order attached to a map showing all property as affected by the same.
