width and described therein, in consideration of the sum of \$500 and of  
the abandonment and closing of Sierra Vista Avenue, as shown on revised map  
of a portion of Map 2 of Ramona, Los Angeles County, of record in Book 16  
pages 79 to 86 Miscellaneous Records of said County, is presented and read;  
and Upon motion of Supervisor Field, duly seconded and carried,  
it is ordered that said deed be and the same is hereby accepted, and the  
Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to file said deed for record in the  
office of the Recorder of this County, and the land conveyed by said deed  
(which said deed is recorded in Book of Deeds #1173 page 68 Los Angeles  
County Records) is hereby declared to be public highway, and it is further or-  
-dered that Sierra Vista Avenue, as herein before described, be and the same is  
hereby vacated and abandoned and the land contained therein is hereby re-  
-stored to acreage.
