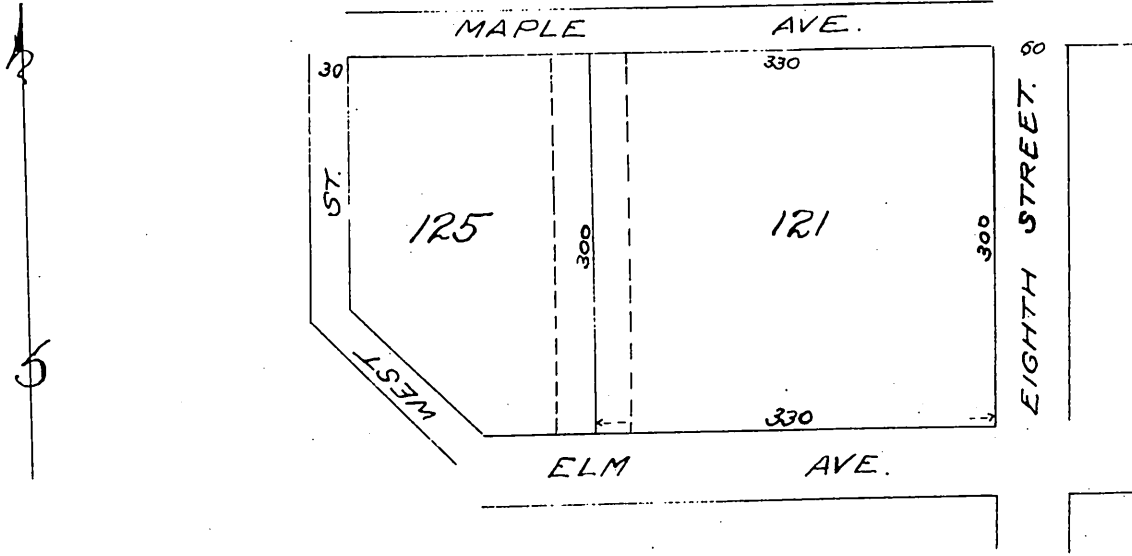




MAP

in East San Gabriel.
(Petition of Miles Pease et al.)

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof, for hearing the petition herein, and no protest having been filed;

Upon motion of Supervisor Kinsden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the petition be and the same is hereby granted, and it is further ordered that that portion of Ninth Street, lying between Elm Avenue and Maple Avenue in the town of East San Gabriel, as per map of said town of East San Gabriel made by J. R. Culver, Civil Engineer, in June 1887, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained returned to acreage, conditioned upon the filing for record by petitioners, in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, a certified copy of this order together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
