Durfy, the petitioner, is sworn and examined, and upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the petition be and the same is hereby granted. And it is further ordered that West Avenue, East Avenue, Park Avenue and Linda Vista Avenue in the Monte Vista Subdivision, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage, subject to any rights the owners of property north of said Monte Vista Subdivision may have for the purpose of ingress and egress.

This order is conditioned upon the filing for record by the petitioner in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County of a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
