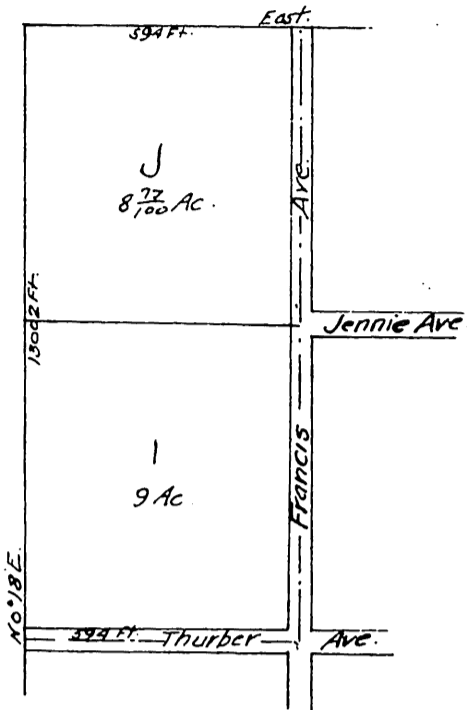




MAP
