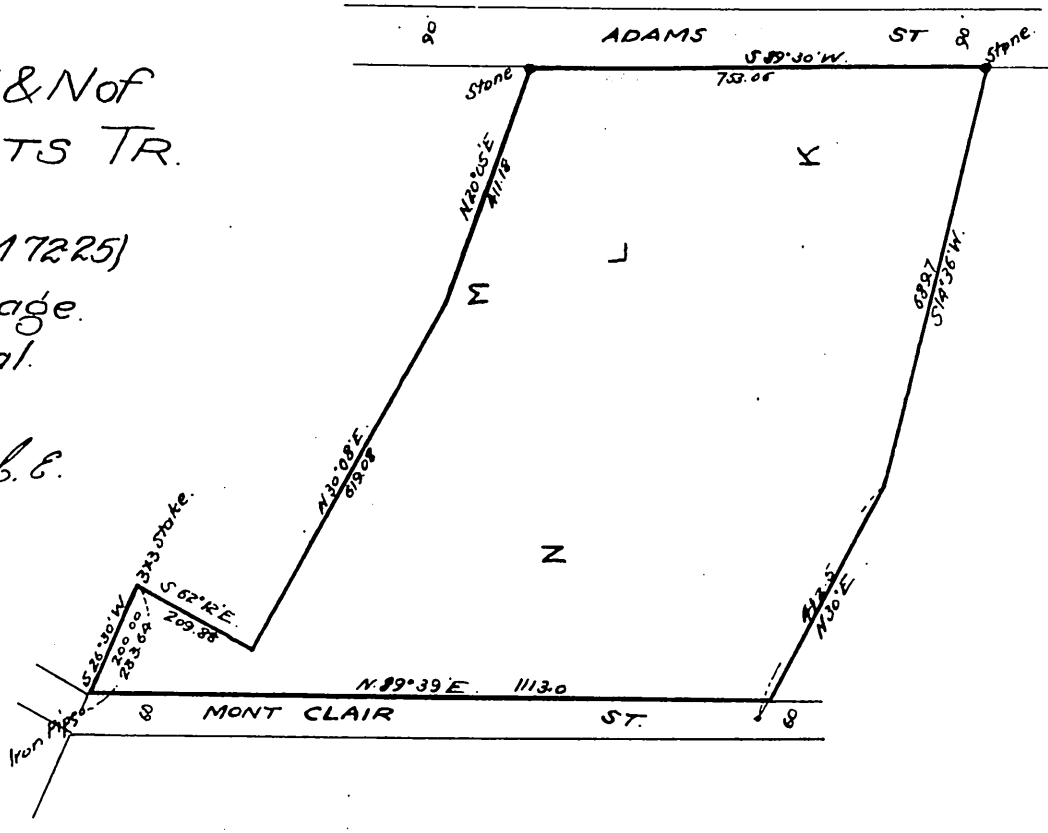




MAP

In re Vacation of Streets
 in Gray and Pitman Tract }

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board, and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition of D. R. Brearley, et al. for the vacation of certain streets and alleys in a portion of the Gray and Pitman Tract, as recorded in book 29, page 29, Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, the matter is called up, and no one appearing in opposition thereto;

Upon motion of Supervisor Wilson, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that Sixth Avenue between the north line of Mont Clair Street and the south line of Adams Street, all of Seventh Avenue between the north line of Ballard Avenue and the south line of Adams Street, all of an unnamed street lying between the north line of Ballard Avenue and the westerly boundary of said tract, all of Ballard Avenue and all Alleys in Blocks K, L and N of the Arlington Heights Tract, be and they are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the filing by the petitioners in the office of the County Recorder of a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
