



Ordinance No. 6833.
(New Series)

An ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles ordering that a certain street in the City of Los Angeles known and designated as Balboa Street be closed up, vacated and abandoned, as contemplated by Ordinance No. 6751, New Series, entitled "An Ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles declaring their intention to close up Balboa Street in the City of Los Angeles," approved October 25th 1901.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That Balboa Street, a certain street in the City of Los Angeles more particularly described as follows, to-wit: That certain street known and designated as Balboa Street (formerly Harriet Street) and delineated and designated as Harriet Street on a certain map of the Charnock Tract, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California recorded in Book 7, page 47 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County in the office of the County Recorder thereof, be and the same is hereby closed up, vacated and abandoned.

Section 2. That said work is for the closing up of Balboa Street, aforesaid, in the City of Los Angeles, particularly described in Section 1 of this Ordinance and it appearing to the City Council of said City that there are no costs or expenses for said work, and that no assessment is necessary to pay such costs and expenses, therefor no commissioners are appointed to assess benefits and damages for said work, or to have general supervision thereof.

Section 3 The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Los Angeles Daily Journal and thereupon and thereafter it shall take effect and be in force.

I hereby certify that the foregoing ordinance was adopted by the Council of the City of Los Angeles at its meeting of December 9th 1901.

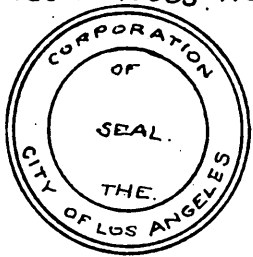
