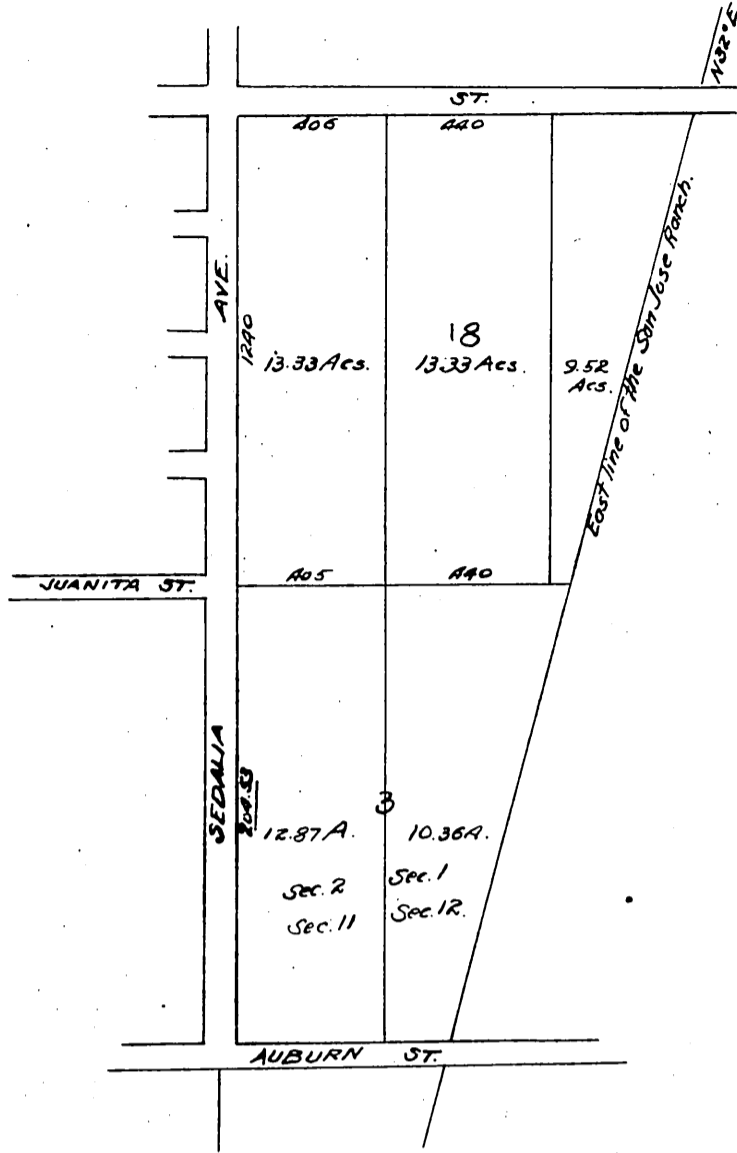

This being the time regularly set by order of continuance of this Board for hearing herein, the matter is called

up and no protests having been filed.

Upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that Juanita Street from the easterly line of Sedalia Avenue to the San Jose grant line, or the easterly terminus of said Juanita Street, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
