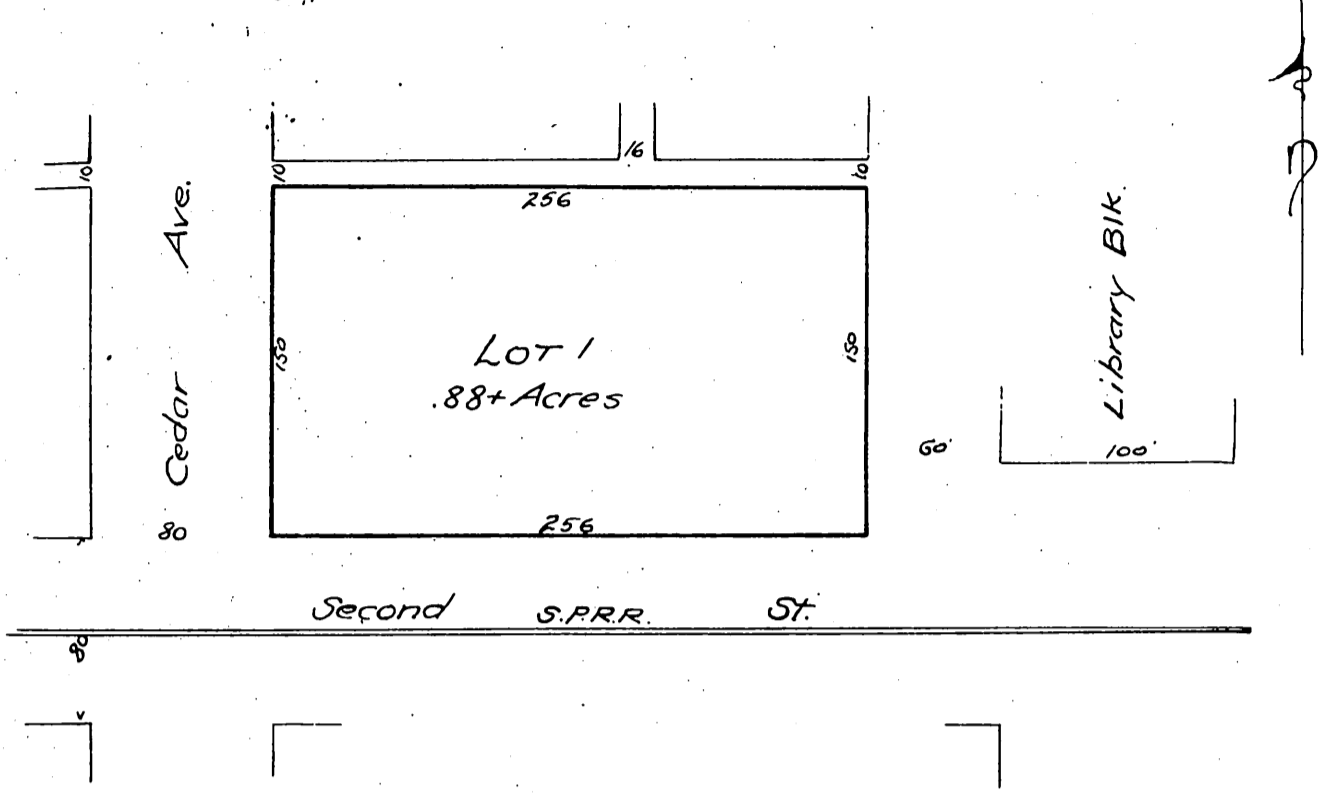


LONG BEACH DEPOT TRACT

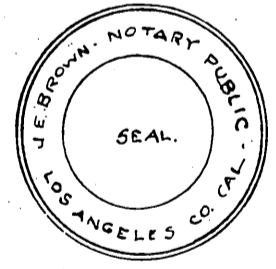
