

In re Vacatin of Garfield and
Cleveland Streets in Arlington
Heights Tract. Granted.

This being the time regular
ly set by order of continuance of
this Board for hearing herein, the matter is taken up, and evidence
having been produced that the Council of the City of Los Angeles had
heretofore this day vacated all that portion of said streets lying
within the corporate limits of Los Angeles City;

Therefore, upon motion of Supervisor Wilson, duly seconded and
carried, it is ordered that all that portion of Garfield and Cleveland
Streets lying between the west line of the City of Los Angeles and the
east line of Second Avenue, be and the same is hereby vacated and aban-
doned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record
in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy
hereof, together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
