On motion of Supervisor Hubbard, duly seconded and carried, it is hereby ordered that the petition of W.J. Nicholson and 13 others (filed on Dec. 29 1890 and set for hearing Jan 15 1891) praying for the Vacation of Muscatine Court, in the Hawkeye Tract, Pasadena, as shown by map accompanying said petition, be granted, and said Muscatine Court be reverted into acreage upon filing map of the same with the Recorder. And it is further ordered that the above order be entered nunc pro tunc as of date Jan. 15, 1891, it appearing from the papers on file that said petition was heard and granted on Jan 15, 1891. but through clerical error was not entered of record on said date.
