R.12 W. and in the W. 1/2 of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 32. be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, excepting therefrom the intersections with Mariana and Mountain View Avenues, and the land therein contained restored to acreage, and the County Surveyor is directed to prepare a map showing all property as affected by said vacation, and the Clerk of this Board is directed to file said map together with a certified copy of this order in the Office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, and the County Recorder is hereby directed to file said certified copy and map without expense to the petitioners.
