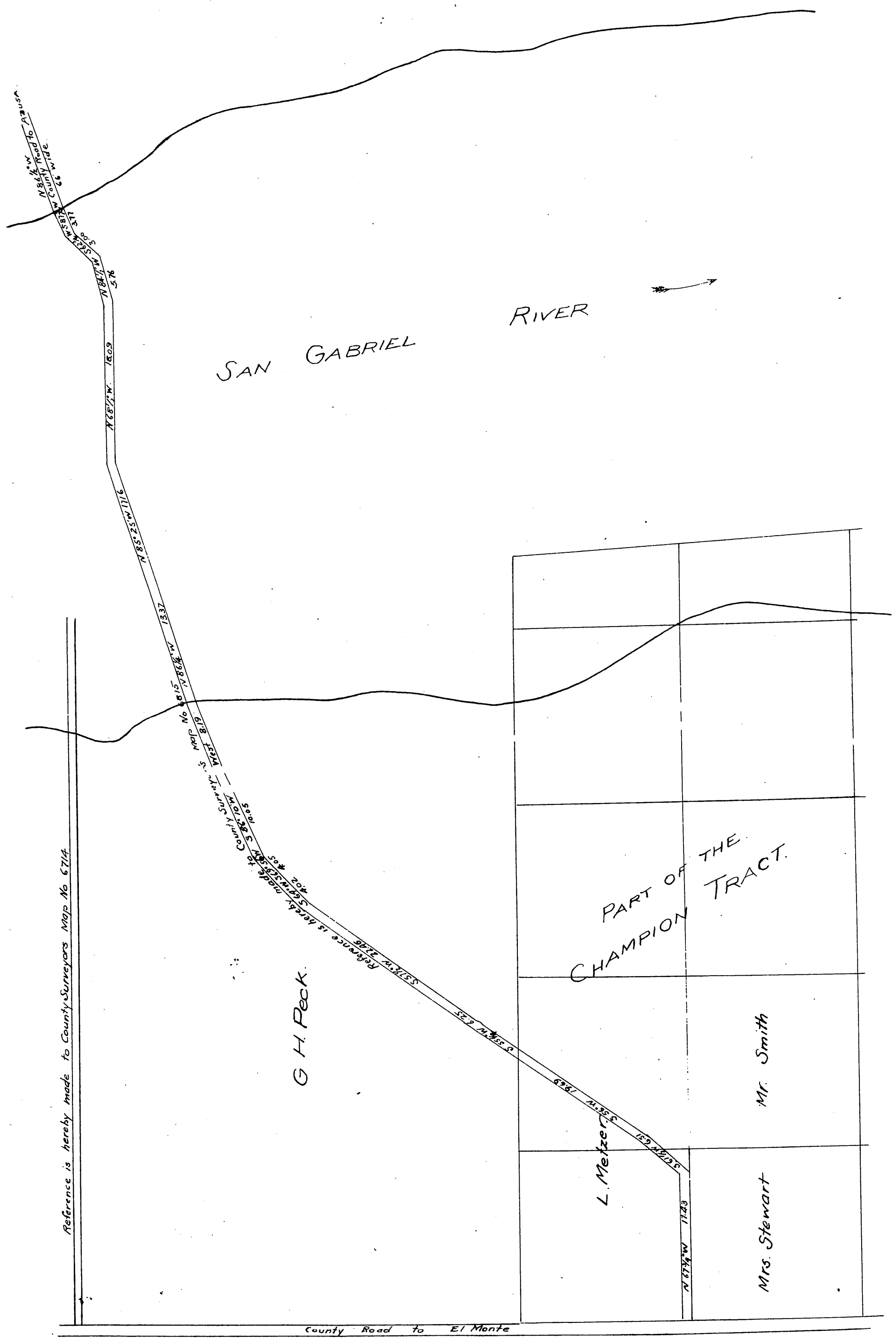
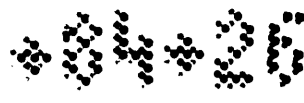


Colored portions of this Map show location of

In re Vacation }
Peck El Monte Road }

Petition, with affidavit of publication, presented & read, and upon motion of Supervisor Hanley duly seconded, said petition was granted. upon the filing a proper map with the County Recorder closing the following described roads, viz:

That part of the San Gabriel and Azusa Road usually known as Peck Road which runs to the Freer crossing, so called, easterly on the Baldwin Tract about one mile to land of Geo. H. Peck, also along said Peck's north line easterly about one mile to the San Gabriel River, also a branch road to Azusa that was granted to begin at the El Monte and Duarte Road at Lo Melzer's to run north and east and diagonally through said Melzer & Geo. H. Peck that was granted on or about July 28th 1880 (See Branch Road Book Page 26)
